


### WASH Biweekly Bulletin - Syria Early Warning Alert and Response Network


#### Highlights

- This report covers **620** drinking water sources monitored in 7 governorates. The percentages in this report represents only the sources monitored.
- 63% (392/620) of the drinking water sources monitored were functioning. 37% (228/620) were not functioning.
- In the areas that their stations are suspended, agricultural wells are used as an alternative water source, and tankers are used in water transportation.
- The treated water sources were 52% (205/392), while the operating stations without treatment were 48% (187/392).
- Of the functioning water stations, 85% (332/392) delieved water using a piping network, 9% (36/392) delivered water using tankering and 6% (24/392) delivered water using both.
- Water quality test performed in the context of investigating the increased numbers of AJS cases in Aleppo city.
- Water quality test performed in the context of investigating the increased numbers of AJS and STF cases in Harim campaigns.
- Water quality test performed in the context of investigating the increased numbers of STF cases in Kafr Deryan Harim.
- Water quality test performed in the context of investigating the ABD alert in Jisr-Ash- Shugur.
- Assessing ice factories numbers and distribution in Aleppo and Atarib cities and certain areas in Rural Damascus for quality control as a posible source of some diseases.



EWARN covers 124 sub-districts, 39 districts in 12 governorates










#### Drinking Water Stations Status in Governorates






# Drinking Water Stations Distribution in Aleppo




### Drinking Water Stations Distribution in Aleppo City




#### Drinking Water Stations Distribution in Idleb







Drinking Water Stations Distribution in Ar-raqqa




### Drinking Water Stations Distribution in Deir-ez-Zor
