

Highlights

- This report covers 623 drinking water sources monitored in 7 governorates. The percentages in this report represents only the sources monitored.
- 64% (399/623) of the drinking water sources monitored were functioning.
- In the areas that their stations are suspended, agricultural wells are used as an alternative water source, and tankers are used in water transportation.
- The treated water sources were 49% (197/399).
- Of the functioning water stations, 86% (345/399) delieved water using a piping network, 8% (31/399) delivered water using tankering and 6% (23/399) delivered water using both.












Drinking Water Stations Status in Governorates




Functioning Drinking Water Stations Clorination Status










Drinking Water Stations Distribution in Aleppo







Drinking Water Stations Distribution in Idleb




Drinking Water Stations Distribution in Hama




Drinking Water Stations Distribution in Ar-raqqa
