

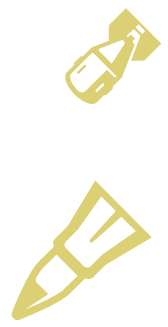
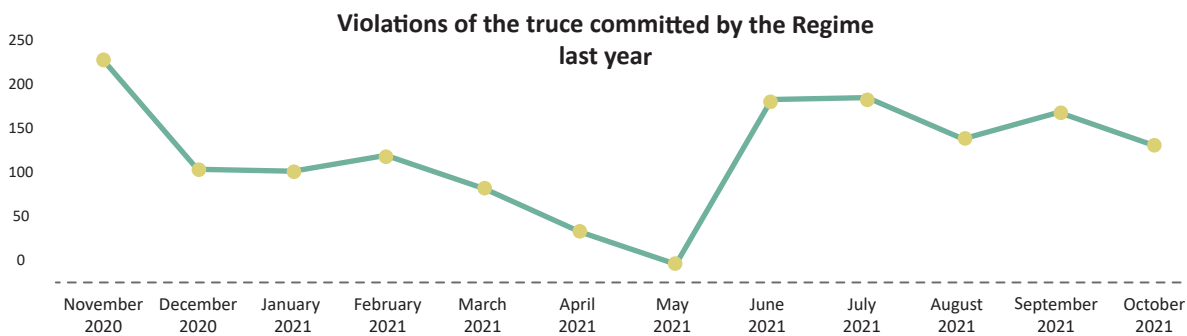

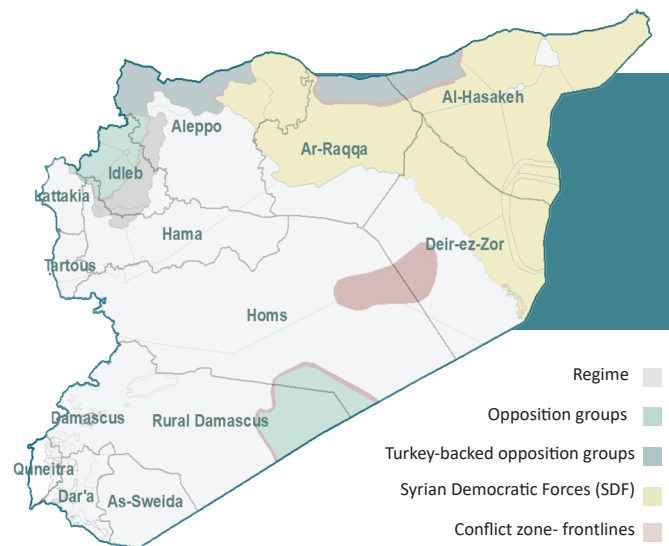

After the Turkey and Russia reached a **ceasefire agreement** in Idlib governorate on March 5, 2020, the Syrian regime and its Russian ally did not bomb northwest Syria with warplanes. However, the **regime continued to bomb** these cities and towns **with heavy artillery and rockets** from ground launchers. On June 2, 2020, **Russian warplanes resumed bombing** cities and towns in northwest Syria, and the regime continued to bombard them with heavy artillery and rockets from ground launchers. Through its network of enumerators, **ACU worked on documenting the regime's breach of the ceasefire**. As of the date of preparing this report, the Syrian regime and its Russian ally have violated the ceasefire **2,760 times**.



After the ceasefire came into effect, **Turkish and Russian forces began conducting joint military patrols** on the contact lines between the regime forces and the opposition forces, as these patrols run along the M4 international road. These joint forces aim to monitor the implementation of the ceasefire and de-escalation on the contact lines. However, **Russian forces stopped participating in these patrols** in mid-September 2020.

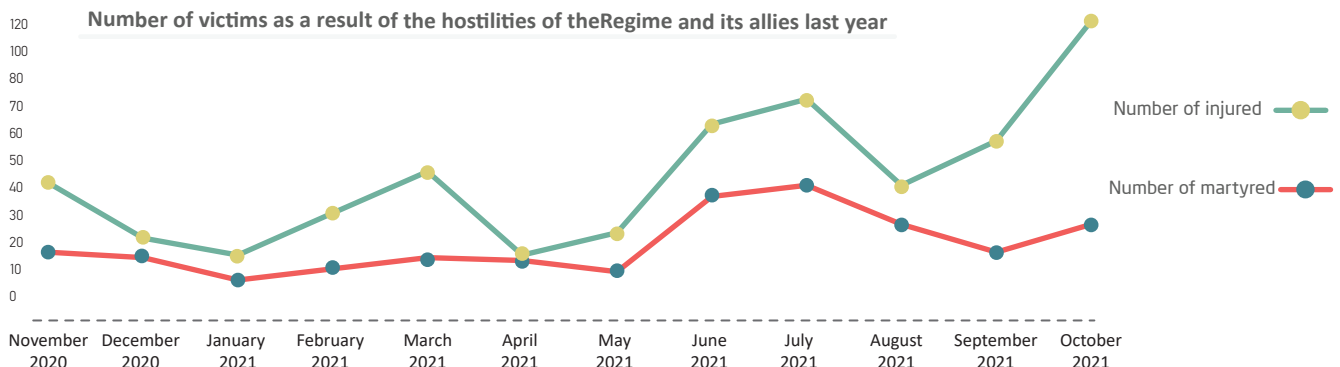
Controlling Parties 14 November 2021



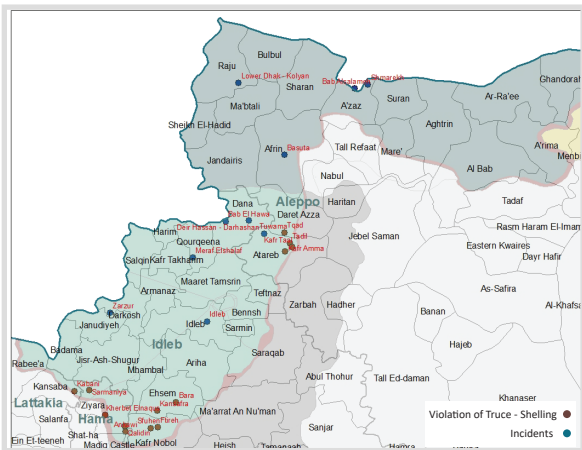

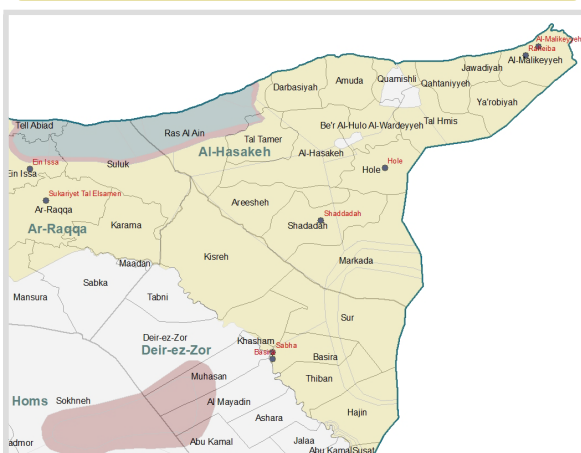
Result of the hostilities of the Regime and its allies in northwest Syria

In northwest Syria: 14 incidents led to the burning of 21 tents

In northwest Syria camps Two IEDs exploded, injuring 2 civilians.

In the central region of Idlib governorate, on November 11, 2021, Russian warplanes targeted with an airstrike farms between the cities of Ma'aret Misrin and Idlib, killing a family of 3 children and their parents, and injuring 6 civilians. Russian warplanes also bombed with several airstrikes the vicinity of Kefraya town, killing a child and injuring 3 civilians. Russian warplanes also bombed with 3 airstrikes the vicinity of Idlib city. In Idlib governorate, on November 11, 2021, the Salvation Government set a new price for a bread package, whereby the price of one package containing 6 loaves and weighing 500 grams was set at 2.5 Turkish liras.

Northeast Syria



In the northern countryside of al-Hasakah, on November 8, 2021, 48 families consisting of 194 IDPs held in al-Hol camp left for their cities and towns in Deir ez-Zor governorate. On November 9, 2021, clan fighting occurred in al-Shaddadah sub-district between the al-Jabour and al-Hazeem (Al-Amo) clans, killing 4 people from the two clans, including a woman. American forces conducted a military patrol in the countryside of al-Malikiyah, after removing their flags from al-Rahiba Airport a few days prior, without knowing the reasons. Two young men were killed in al-Shaddadah sub-district while digging tunnels for oil pipelines, as one of the pipelines fell on them and killed them. On November 10, 2021, the so-called Syrian Democratic Forces (SDF) broke the siege on the regime-controlled security box in al-Qamishli city. However, they imposed restrictions on the movement of the regime's fighters outside the security box.

In the northern countryside of Aleppo, on November 8, 2021, Russian forces dispatched new military reinforcements to their forces stationed in Mennegh Military Airport in Tall Rifat sub-district. On November 11, 2021, unidentified warplanes targeted with an airstrike the vicinity of al-Hamran crossing point near Jarablus city. In the northern countryside of ar-Raqqa, on November 10, 2021, Ain Issa city witnessed tension between the regime forces and the Syrian Democratic Forces (SDF) after SDF denied entry of a cargo car carrying logistical equipment to the regime, as the regime forces had intended to establish a military headquarters near one of its checkpoints in the city, but SDF did not allow them, which led to a dispute that developed into a shooting between the two parties, injuring a number of fighters on both sides. After the dispute and shooting, the regime forces withdrew from the military point and removed the military checkpoint. On November 13, 2021, Russian forces dispatched military reinforcements to their military bases near Ain Issa city and Tal Al-Saman town, as they intend to establish a helipad for their helicopters near al-Tarfawi base in the eastern countryside of ar-Raqqa.
