



After the Turkey and Russia reached a ceasefire agreement in Idlib governorate on March 5, 2020, the Syrian regime and its Russian ally did not bomb northwest Syria with warplanes. However, the regime continued to bomb these cities and towns with heavy artillery and rockets from ground launchers. On June 2, 2020, Russian warplanes resumed bombing cities and towns in northwest Syria, and the regime continued to bombard them with heavy artillery and rockets from ground launchers. Through its network of enumerators, ACU worked on documenting the regime's breach of the ceasefire. As of the date of preparing this report, the Syrian regime and its Russian ally have violated the ceasefire 2,806 times.




After the ceasefire came into effect, Turkish and Russian forces began conducting joint military patrols on the contact lines between the regime forces and the opposition forces, as these patrols run along the M4 international road. These joint forces aim to monitor the implementation of the ceasefire and de-escalation on the contact lines. However, Russian forces stopped participating in these patrols in mid-September 2020.



In the central region of Idlib governorate, on November 15, 2021, the regime forces bombed Taftanaz city with heavy artillery, targeting a Free Police station in the city, resulting in the injury of 2 civilians. Russian warplanes bombed the towns of Majdalaya, Deir Sunbul and Maar Belit with an airstrike. In the western countryside of Aleppo, the regime forces bombed the town of Kafr Noran with heavy artillery, killing a woman and her child and injuring 4 civilians. On November 18, 2021, the Salvation Government set a new price for bread in Idlib governorate, where the price of a bread package containing 5 loaves and weighing 450 grams became 2.5 Turkish liras.

Northeast Syria



In the eastern countryside of Deir ez-Zor, on November 15, 2021, an unidentified airplane targeted an Iranian convoy near Albukamal city. According to some information received, high-ranking Iranian figures were in the convoy. On November 19, 2021, ISIL fighters attacked the Faisal oil field in the desert of Al-Busira sub-district and burned it. It is worth noting that the oil field is under the control of the so-called Syrian Democratic Forces (SDF). A Russian military convoy tried to cross the regime-controlled areas to the town of Salhiya, which is under the control of SDF. However, civilians demonstrated at the factories roundabout and prevented the Russian convoy from crossing; Russian warplanes flew at a low altitude, and soon afterwards, the area witnessed a deployment of American forces.

In the eastern countryside of Aleppo, on November 16, 2021, SDF opened fire on a civilian and injured him while he was working on his agricultural land near Awn al-Dadat town north of Manbij. On November 17, 2021, a group of SDF fighters raped a 4-year-old girl. Then, they threw her on the road of Deir Jamal town, and she was later found dead. The town's locals chased the perpetrators and were able to arrest one of them.

In the northern countryside of ar-Raqqa, on November 16, 2021, SDF forces ran over an old man and arrested two of his sons. On November 18, 2021, SDF prevented the regime forces from taking its wounded fighters to the Ain Issa Hospital, after they were injured in a landmine explosion. The regime forces and SDF held a closed meeting at at-Tabqa Military Airport, which was attended by Russian officers and an SDF commander. In the northern countryside of al-Hasaka, on November 18, 2021, tensions escalated between the regime forces and SDF in al-Hasakah city, after the regime fighters kidnapped a number of SDF fighters in al-Hasakah city, prompting SDF to mobilize its forces and launch an attack against the regime forces and arrest 11 of its fighters. Al-Qamishli city witnessed tensions between the regime forces and SDF after clashes had erupted between the two parties several days prior.
