



After the Turkey and Russia reached a **ceasefire agreement** in Idlib governorate on March 5, 2020, the Syrian regime and its Russian ally did not bomb northwest Syria with warplanes. However, the regime continued to bomb these cities and towns with heavy artillery and rockets from ground launchers. On June 2, 2020, Russian warplanes resumed bombing cities and towns in northwest Syria, and the regime continued to bombard them with heavy artillery and rockets from ground launchers. ACU worked on documenting the regime's breach of the ceasefire. As of the date of preparing this report, the Syrian regime and its Russian ally have violated the ceasefire 2,842 times.




After the ceasefire came into effect, **Turkish and Russian forces began conducting joint military patrols** on the contact lines between the regime forces and the opposition forces, as these patrols run along the M4 international road. These joint forces aim to monitor the implementation of the ceasefire and de-escalation on the contact lines. However, **Russian forces stopped participating in these patrols** in mid-September 2020.

In the central region of Idlib governorate, on November 22, 2021, Russian warplanes targeted the Talita town with several airstrikes, killing 2 civilians and injuring 7 others from the Druze community while they were picking olives. On November 24, 2021, the regime forces bombed the towns of Ain Larouz and Josef with heavy artillery, killing a civilian in Ain Larouz town and injuring another in Joseph town. In the western countryside of Aleppo, the regime forces bombed a school in Kafr Ta'al town with heavy artillery, which led to its destruction. On November 25, 2021, Russian warplanes targeted Majdalaya town with an airstrike, killing a woman and injuring 4 civilians while they were picking olives. In the northern countryside of Aleppo, on November 22, 2021, activists launched a large media campaign on social media to highlight the suffering resulting from the large number of leishmaniasis cases that children greatly suffer from. In Idlib governorate, on November 24, 2021, the Salvation Government set a new price for a bread package, whereby the price of one package containing 7 loaves and weighing 600 grams was set at 3.5 Turkish liras.



In the western countryside of Daraa, on November 29, 2021, the regime forces bombed Nawa city with heavy artillery, killing 3 civilians and injuring 9 others. The regime's bombing of the city came in response to targeting its vehicles with an IED on the road connecting Nawa city to the Sheikh Bahr town, which resulted in killing 3 regime fighters. Therefore, the regime responded by bombing civilian homes in Nawa city. The regime also arrested 16 farmers from Nawa city after the explosion.

In the northern countryside of al-Hasaka, on November 23, 2021, a car affiliated with the so-called Syrian Democratic Forces (SDF) ran over a two-and-a-half-year-old child near ad-Darbasiyyah city, which led to the child's death. Kharab al-Jabr Airport, near al-Hasaka city, was bombed with unidentified missiles. It is noteworthy that the US forces occupy this airport as a military base. On November 24, 2021, an SDF-affiliated vehicle ran over an 11-year-old boy, which killed him. This sparked the anger of the child's family, who insulted the SDF fighters, so SDF brought in military reinforcements, raided the child's parents' home, and arrested his father, two of his brothers, and two of his relatives. On November 26, 2021, SDF kidnapped 3 underage girls to recruit them into the compulsory conscription camps. SDF arrested 3 Iraqi refugees from al-Hol Camp and accused them of being affiliated with ISIL. SDF refused to provide the Tal Al-Saman residents with their bread allowances, after verbal altercations between the locals and SDF fighters. A mine planted by the SDF militia exploded in the Nasiriyah town, close to Tal Al-Saman town, killing a civilian and his son. On November 27, 2021, SDF kidnapped a 15-year-old boy from al-Qamishli city to recruit him into the compulsory conscription camps. SDF released 900 detainees from prison, who were accused of having been affiliated with ISIL in the past.
