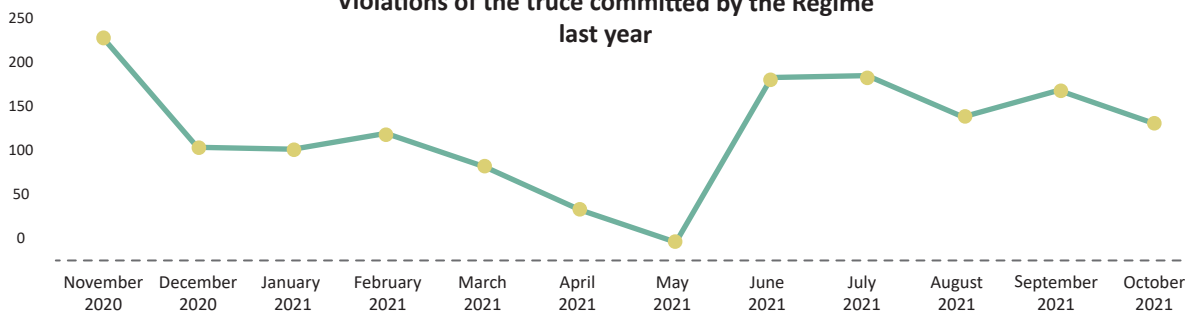

2,732 violations of truce

committed by the Regime and its Russian ally

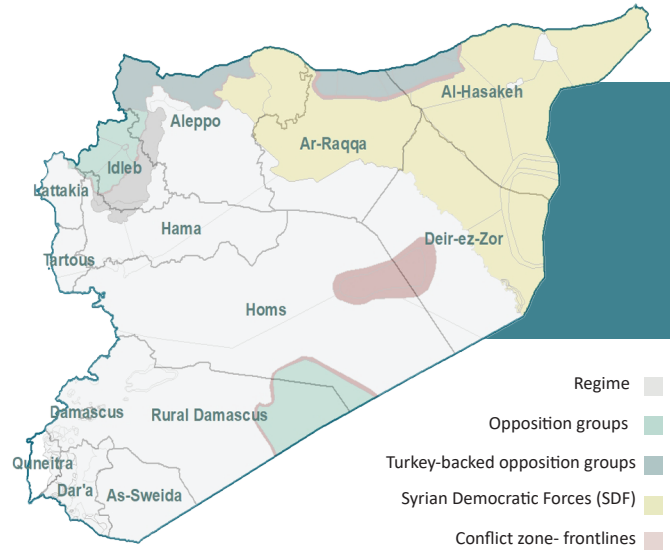
After the Turkey and Russia reached a **ceasefire agreement** in Idlib governorate on March 5, 2020, the Syrian regime and its Russian ally did not bomb northwest Syria with warplanes. However, the **regime continued to bomb** these cities and towns **with heavy artillery and rockets** from ground launchers. On June 2, 2020, **Russian warplanes resumed bombing** cities and towns in northwest Syria, and the regime continued to bombard them with heavy artillery and rockets from ground launchers. Through its network of enumerators, **ACU worked on documenting the regime's breach of the ceasefire**. As of the date of preparing this report, the Syrian regime and its Russian ally have violated the ceasefire **2,732 times**.

Violations of the truce committed by the Regime last year



After the ceasefire came into effect, **Turkish and Russian forces began conducting joint military patrols** on the contact lines between the regime forces and the opposition forces, as these patrols run along the M4 international road. These joint forces aim to monitor the implementation of the ceasefire and de-escalation on the contact lines. However, **Russian forces stopped participating in these patrols** in mid-September 2020.

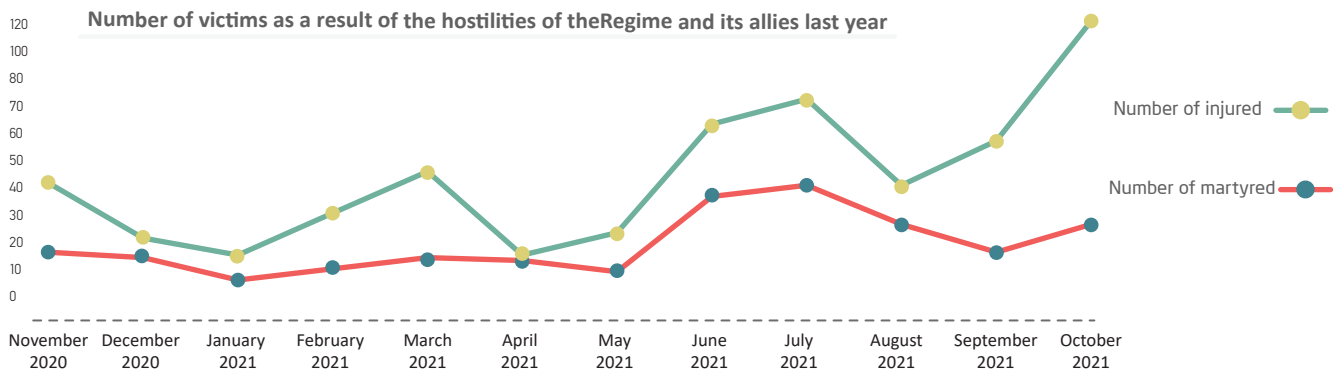
Controlling Parties 07 November 2021



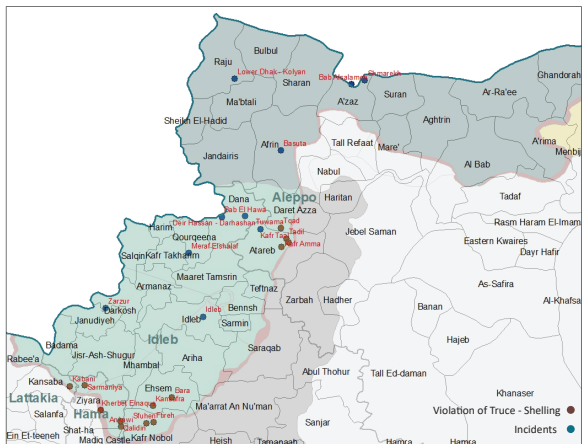

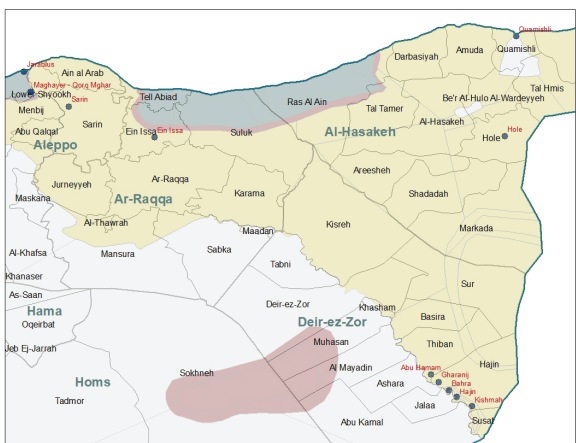
Result of the hostilities of the Regime and its allies in northwest Syria

In northwest Syria:
4 IEDs exploded, killing 3 civilians and injuring 11 others.

In northwest Syria camps
7 accidents led to the burning of 12 tents and injuring 1 other.

In the central region of Idlib governorate, on November 1, 2021, the regime forces bombed with heavy artillery the town of Kansafra, injuring 5 civilians. The shelling targeted civilians while they were picking olives. In the western countryside of Idlib, on November 6, 2021, Russian warplanes targeted the vicinity of the Mishmishan town with 6 raids, injuring a civilian and killing a number of livestock. In the northern countryside of Aleppo, on November 7, 2021, an unidentified missile fell on Jarablus city, killing a civilian and wounding 3 others.

Northeast Syria



In the eastern countryside of Deir ez-Zor, on November 4, 2021, locals demonstrated in the towns of Abu Hamam, al-Kashkiya, al-Bahra and Hajin against the so-called Syrian Democratic Forces (SDF), the main reason for the demonstrations being the deteriorating services and living situation in the eastern countryside of Deir ez-Zor. In the eastern countryside of Aleppo, on November 4, 2021, Russian forces began rehabilitating the military airport near Sarin city. The airport was established by US forces earlier during their military operation against ISIL. In the northern countryside of ar-Raqqa, on November 5, 2021, military reinforcements of the regime forces arrived in Ain Issa city.

The Democratic Union Party (PYD) expressed willingness to hand over the oil fields in northeast Syria to the Syrian regime, provided that the file of oil and resources in east Syria be part of the final dialogue with the regime. Syria's eastern regions witnessed a shift in the attitudes of SDF and the Kurdish parties present in the area towards the regime forces. This transformation came after Turkey threatened a possible military operation in areas under SDF's control. According to several sources, the US President's administration's decision not to extend the exemption from sanctions against the American oil company "Delta Crescent Energy", which is active in northeast Syria, is based on the hope that the US will be able to negotiate with Russia the entry of aid into Syria in exchange for withdrawing from the oil fields. Russian oil companies contracting with the regime are looking to work in the oil fields in eastern Syria as soon as the US forces leave the fields. In the northern countryside of al-Hasakah, on November 4, 2021, Syrian Democratic Forces (SDF) removed al-Quwwatli military checkpoint in the center of al-Qamishli city, and so broke the siege imposed on the regime-controlled security box. A child died in al-Hol camp as a result of lack of health care.
