

NORTHEAST AND NORTHWEST 8-15 February; 2022


## 3,025 violations of truce committed by the Regime and its Russian ally

After the Turkey and Russia reached a **ceasefire agreement** in Idlib governorate on March 5, 2020, the Syrian regime and its Russian ally did not bomb northwest Syria with warplanes. However, the **regime continued to bomb** these cities and towns **with heavy artillery and rockets** from ground launchers. On June 2, 2020, **Russian warplanes resumed bombing** cities and towns in northwest Syria, and the regime continued to bombard them with heavy artillery and rockets from ground launchers. Through its network of enumerators, **ACU worked on documenting the regime's breach of the ceasefire**. As of the date of preparing this report, the Syrian regime and its Russian ally have violated the ceasefire **3,025 times**.



After the ceasefire came into effect, **Turkish and Russian forces began conducting joint military patrols** on the contact lines between the regime forces and the opposition forces, as these patrols run along the M4 international road. These joint forces aim to monitor the implementation of the ceasefire and de-escalation on the contact lines. However, **Russian forces stopped participating in these patrols** in mid-September 2020.


### Controlling Parties 15 February 2022




### Since the beginning of the truce and until this date

Result of the hostilities of the Regime and its allies in northwest Syria


In northwest Syria: an IED detonated, killing one civilian and injuring another.

In northwest Syria camps 21 incidents led to the burning of 26 tents and the injury of 5 IDPs.

In the central area of Idlib governorate, on February 12, 2022, regime forces shelled Ma'arrat al-Na'asan town with heavy artillery, killing five civilians from one family, including two children and two women, and injuring one man and one woman. One of the remnants of the regime's previous shelling exploded near Taftanaz city, killing a civilian and injuring a woman. On February 13, 2022, regime forces shelled the outskirts of Kansafra town with heavy artillery, killing a civilian. In the northern countryside of Aleppo, on February 12, 2022, the so-called Syrian Democratic Forces (SDF) shelled the outskirts of Jarablus city, injuring six civilians, including two children.

In the northern countryside of Idlib, on February 10, 2022, Hay'at Tahrir al-Sham (HTS) fighters shot a woman while she was transporting heating fuel (a gallon of diesel) from the countryside of Aleppo to Idlib (near the Deir al-Balut crossing). HTS fighters shot the woman in the head, killing her. The woman is a displaced widow and has 3 children, no more than 10 years old. As a result, there were civilian demonstrations denouncing HTS practices, and HTS opened fire on civilians to disperse them, injuring one child. In the central area of Idlib governorate, a two-story house in Corinne town (Ariha center) collapsed over an 8-member family (two parents and six children). The collapse led to the death of the parents and five children, while one child survived. The house collapsed due to rain and soil slide; also, the house was built without foundations (concrete poles), and it is old. The Free Civil Defense teams worked to remove the rubble and recover the bodies from underneath. In the western countryside of Aleppo, on February 12, 2022, security forces seized a car that was attempting to smuggle narcotic substances into Idlib governorate from the Darat Izza crossing. The car contained 1 million narcotic pills (Captagon).

Northeast Syria



In the eastern countryside of Aleppo, on February 9, 2022, the so-called Syrian Democratic Forces (SDF) shelled the Abu al-Zindeen crossing, which connects areas controlled by the regime and the opposition in the countryside of Al-Bab, killing one person and injuring four (fighters of the opposition's National Army).

In the northern countryside of al-Hasaka, on February 9, 2022, an SDF military patrol opened fire on children and women in Al-Hol Camp, killing one child and injuring six women and children. SDF opened fire on the IDPs after a fight ensued between them and an SDF patrol.

In the eastern countryside of Deir ez-Zor, on February 9, 2022, SDF conducted an arrest campaign at dawn at the entrance of Basira city, and there were clashes between SDF and the family of al-Jamil (al-Kubaisa), which led to the death of a civilian and the injury of his brother. The clashes coincided with International Coalition warplanes flying over the area. On February 10, 2022, a group of ISIL fighters infiltrated the SDF headquarters in Al-Shaheel at night, killing five SDF fighters and setting the headquarters on fire before fleeing. Unidentified assailants attacked the al-Kabr water station in the Kasra sub-district, and the losses were not identified. Also, unknown assailants attacked the Theban water station.

In southern Syria, on February 8, 2022, Jordan thwarted the smuggling of narcotic pills (Captagon) hidden in the guts of live sheep. Several days prior, the Counter Narcotics Administration announced that it had thwarted an attempt to smuggle 1 million Captagon pills hidden in vehicle tires. On February 11, 2022, a Jordanian army official confirmed that the Jordanian Border Guard had been able to thwart an attempt to smuggle large quantities of narcotics and weapons from Syria. The guards thwarted an attempt to smuggle more than 9 million Captagon pills, 39,000 Tramadol pills, more than 7,000 packages of hashish, and some weapons.
