




FIELD DEVELOPMENTS

NORTHEAST AND NORTHWEST 15-21 March; 2022

3,059 violations of truce committed by the Regime and its Russian ally

After the Turkey and Russia reached a **ceasefire agreement** in Idlib governorate on March 5, 2020, the Syrian regime and its Russian ally did not bomb northwest Syria with warplanes. However, the **regime continued to bomb** these cities and towns **with heavy artillery and rockets** from ground launchers. On June 2, 2020, **Russian warplanes resumed bombing** cities and towns in northwest Syria, and the regime continued to bombard them with heavy artillery and rockets from ground launchers. Through its network of enumerators, **ACU worked on documenting the regime's breach of the ceasefire**. As of the date of preparing this report, the Syrian regime and its Russian ally have violated the ceasefire 3,059 times.



After the ceasefire came into effect, Turkish and Russian forces began conducting joint military patrols on the contact lines between the regime forces and the opposition forces, as these patrols run along the M4 international road. These joint forces aim to monitor the implementation of the ceasefire and de-escalation on the contact lines. However, Russian forces stopped participating in these patrols in mid-September 2020.

In northwestern Syria camps

8 incidents led to the burning of 8 tents and the injury of 5 displaced people, and 1,268 tents were damaged as a result of rainstorms and severe winds.

In the central region of Idlib governorate, on 15 March 2022, Russian warplanes bombed with several raids the towns of Ma'arat Misrin, Shannan, and Bazapur. On 16 March 2022, regime forces shelled the outskirts of Ma'arrat Naasan town, injuring a child while herding sheep.

Northeast Syria Deir-ez-Zo

In Al-Hasakah governorate, on 16 March 2022, the people of Qarmanah village in the countryside of Darbasiyah, north of Al-Hasakah, found the bodies of two young men with signs of torture. Local sources said that the bodies belonged to two young men in their early twenties, indicating that the people found them 300 meters away from the Turkish border. The two bodies were taken to the Khabat hospital in Darbasiyah, and the medical examination confirmed that the two youths had lost their lives as a result of severe torture. One of the bodies was identified as belonging to a young man named Adel Mohamed Al-Bader, born in 2001, while the other body has not been identified. The so-called Syrian Democratic Forces (SDF) accused the Turkish gendarmerie directly of committing the crime, but the sources confirmed that the location where the two bodies were found is far away, and the Turkish gendarmerie cannot reach it, being inside Syria and is fully under SDF's control. It should be noted that the residents of Al-Zuhoor neighborhood in Al-Hasakeh city had previously found the body of a young man in his twenties, killed by three bullets, with signs of torture. On 17 March 2022, the local council of Ras al-Ain city announced it imported quantities of hay for livestock breeders, and it announced that those wishing to register for the purchase of hay should visit the Directorate of Agriculture. The hay was imported from Turkey, but local sources confirmed that the imported quantities are not sufficient for livestock in the region for more than 4 days.

in the eastern countryside of Deir ez-Zor, On 17 March 2022, the teaching staff in the towns of al-Kasra, Zaghir, Jazira, and Jazarat announced the start of an open strike until their demands are met, which include an increase in their salaries to be in line with the exchange rate of the US dollar, in light of the decline of the Syrian pound, and also to activate the role of the teachers' union and to appoint school guards. Hence, the teaching staff in the western countryside of Deir ez-Zor joined the teaching staff in the towns of Thiban, Suwaidan Jazirah, and al-Tayana in the eastern countryside of Deir ez-Zor in an open strike until their demands are met.
