



# violations of truce committed by the Regime and its Russian ally

After the Turkey and Russia reached a ceasefire agreement in Idlib governorate on March 5, 2020, the Syrian regime and its Russian ally did not bomb northwest Syria with warplanes. However, the regime continued to bomb these cities and towns with heavy artillery and rockets from ground launchers. On June 2, 2020, Russian warplanes resumed bombing cities and towns in northwest Syria, and the regime continued to bombard them with heavy artillery and rockets from ground launchers. Through its network of enumerators, ACU worked on documenting the regime's breach of the ceasefire. As of the date of preparing this report, the Syrian regime and its Russian ally have violated the ceasefire 2,577 times.



After the ceasefire came into effect, Turkish and Russian forces began conducting joint military patrols on the contact lines between the regime forces and the opposition forces, as these patrols run along the M4 international road. These joint forces aim to monitor the implementation of the ceasefire and de-escalation on the contact lines. However, Russian forces stopped participating in these patrols in mid-September 2020.


Result of the hostilities of the Regime and its allies in northwest Syria

In the northern countryside of Aleppo I In northwest Syria camps : IEDs exploded in the city of Jarablus | 13 accidents led to the burning and Afrin, killing 3 civilians and of 17 tents and the flooding of 3 wounding 18 others.

In the northern countryside of Aleppo: On September 26, 2021, Russian warplanes bombed the Afrin sub-district with 4 air raids. The first targeted a small town near the town of Kabashin. The second targeted a mountain near the town of Baslahaya. The third targeted a military area in Jabal Al-Ahlam, east of Al-Basouta town. The fourth targeted the headquarters of the National Army in Brad town, killing 11 fighters and wounding dozens.

#### **Northeast Syria**



In the eastern countryside of Deir ez-Zor: On September 24, 2021, a mine exploded in al-Shafa town, killing 3 civilians. On September 28, 2021, unidentified warplanes, believed to be affiliated with the International Coalition, bombed the al-Mazare' area near al-Mayadeen city. The bombing targeted a center for training Iranian militias. On September 29, 2021, a landmine exploded in al-Bahra town, killing 2 children.

In the northern countryside of Hasaka: On September 24, 2021, the Kurdish National Council called to participate in a protest against the decisions of the Autonomous Administration to raise the prices of fuel and bread, and to demand the freedom of detainees. The cities of al-Hasaka, Qamishli, Tel Tamer, Amuda, Derbasiyah and Rmelan witnessed a protest by the people, because of the bad services and high prices. Al-Qamishli residents demonstrated in front of the United Nations office. A spokesman for the Kurdish National Council issued a statement: "There is a famine now; people need aid; people's living conditions are getting worse day by day, due to the rapid and uncontrolled rise in the prices of all necessary items and basics of life." The protests in al-Qamishli city escalated into violence after members of the Revolutionary Youth Organization (which is affiliated with the Kurdistan Workers' Party (PKK)) attacked the protesters and started throwing stones at them. Al-Asayish forces (police forces affiliated with the Syrian Democratic Forces (SDF)) intervened to end the clash, which resulted in the injury of 5 civilian protestors. The next day, unidentified persons attacked the Kurdish National Council's offices and threw Molotov cocktails at them. On September 26, 2021, Russian warplanes conducted an airstrike against the vicinity of al-Dardaara town, east of Ras al-Ain. On September 28, 2021, a fire broke out in the fifth sector of al-Hol camp near al-Hol town, burning 3 adjacent tents without causing any human casualties. A fire also broke out in the fourth sector of the camp, burning two tents without causing any casualties.
