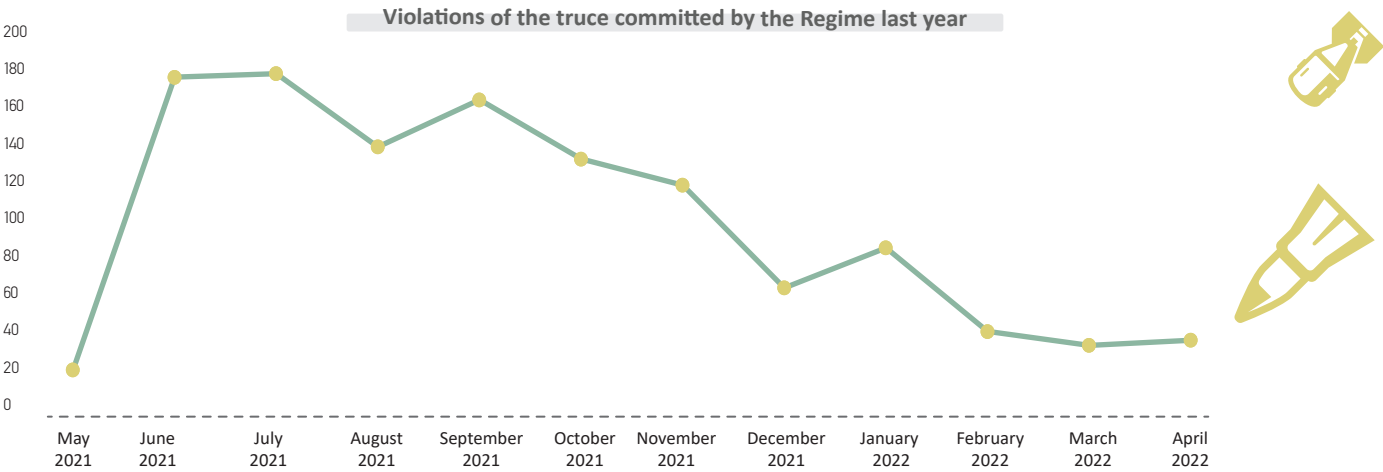

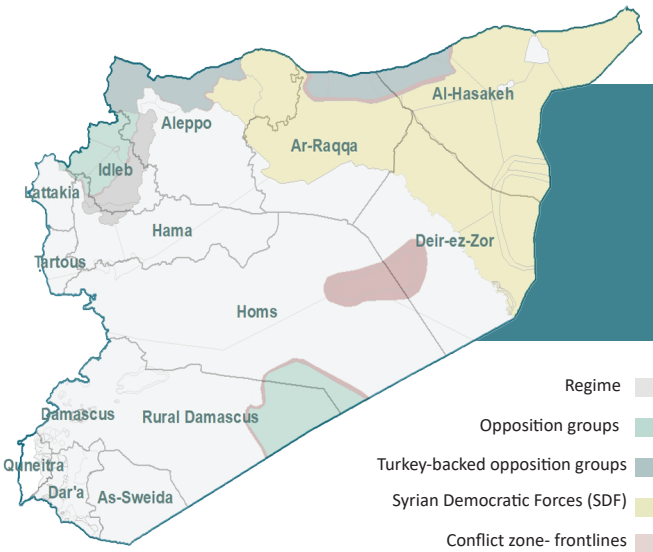
3,113 violations of truce committed by the Regime and its Russian ally

After the Turkey and Russia reached a ceasefire agreement in Idlib governorate on March 5, 2020, the Syrian regime and its Russian ally did not bomb northwest Syria with warplanes. However, the regime continued to bomb these cities and towns with heavy artillery and rockets from ground launchers. On June 2, 2020, Russian warplanes resumed bombing cities and towns in northwest Syria, and the regime continued to bombard them with heavy artillery and rockets from ground launchers. Through its network of enumerators, ACU worked on documenting the regime's breach of the ceasefire. As of the date of preparing this report, the Syrian regime and its Russian ally have violated the ceasefire 3,113 times.



After the ceasefire came into effect, Turkish and Russian forces began conducting joint military patrols on the contact lines between the regime forces and the opposition forces, as these patrols run along the M4 international road. These joint forces aim to monitor the implementation of the ceasefire and de-escalation on the contact lines. However, Russian forces stopped participating in these patrols in mid-September 2020.

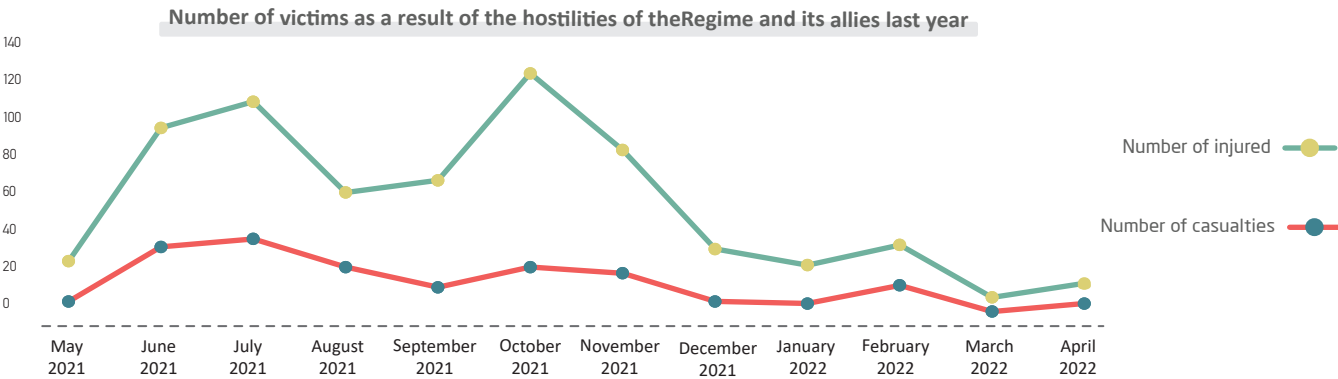
Controlling Parties 7 May 2022



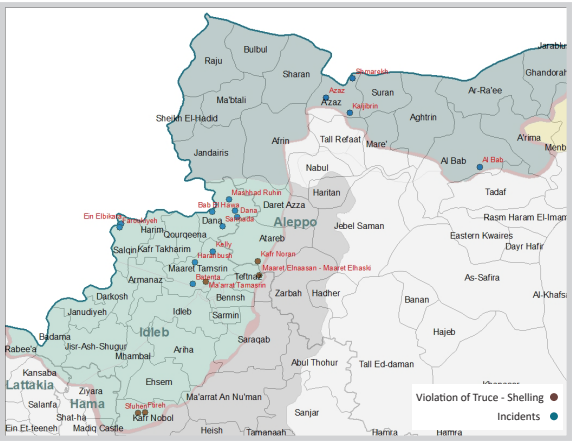

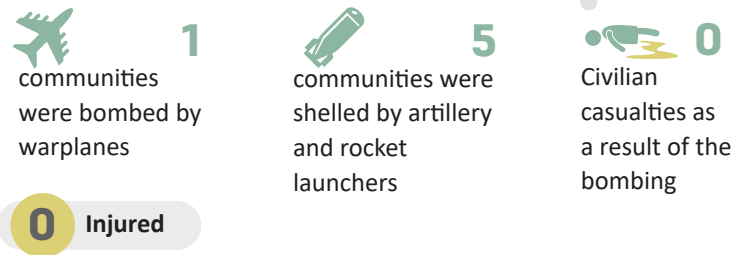

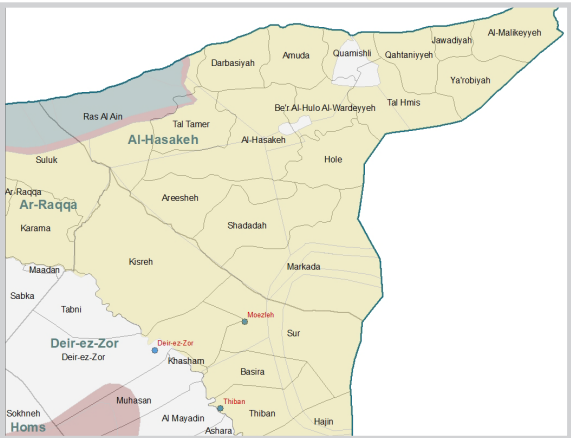
In northwest Syria:
two IEDs exploded, killing two civilians.

In northwest Syria camps:
29 accidents led to the burning of 10 tents. Also, 1,002 tents were damaged by storms.

In the northern countryside of Aleppo, on 4 May 2022, the so-called Syrian Democratic Forces (SDF) shelled with heavy artillery the outskirts of Azaz Hospital. SDF also shelled with heavy artillery a Turkish military base in the town of Keljabrin, killing a Turkish soldier.

In northwestern Syria, between 29 April and 1 May 2022, heavy winds and rains damaged IDP tents, with storms completely destroying 207 tents, partially destroying 724 tents, and destroying all shelter materials of displaced families. On 5 May 2022, rainwater seeped into the bulk of the mud houses in Ibn Sariqi camp near the town of Faruqiya, where the camp is located at the end of a big valley in a low area, in addition to the fragile nature of its mud houses, resulting in water leakage from the ceilings of rooms without rain insulation. Between 3-6 May 2022, floods and severe winds occurred in northwestern Syria, resulting in damage to IDP camps in Idlib governorate, where 59 tents were completely destroyed, while 12 tents were partially damaged, in addition to damaging the shelter materials of displaced families in all tents.

Northeast Syria





In the city of ar-Raqqah, on 4 May 2022, the so-called Syrian Democratic Forces (SDF) arrested more than 100 young people during the month of Ramadan. The arrest was carried out with the aim of drafting the youths into the compulsory recruitment in the SDF camps. SDF transferred all the detained youths to the 17th Division.



In the eastern countryside of Deir ez-Zor, on 4 May 2022, the Coalition Forces carried out an airdrop operation in the city of Thiban and arrested five persons, including a doctor, who was arrested while working in his clinic. On 7 May 2022, unidentified airplanes believed to be affiliated with the International Coalition bombed Hawija Kati' near the city of Deir ez-Zor, killing nine Iranian Revolutionary Guard militia fighters and wounding eight. Iranian militias responded by shelling the area of Mazizalah in the vicinity of the Koniko gas field north of the city of Deir ez-Zor, where the international coalition forces are stationed.
