After the Turkey and Russia reached a **ceasefire agreement** in Idlib governorate on March 5, 2020, the Syrian regime and its Russian ally did not bomb northwest Syria with warplanes. However, the **regime continued to bomb** these cities and towns **with heavy artillery and rockets** from ground launchers. On June 2, 2020, **Russian warplanes resumed bombing** cities and towns in northwest Syria, and the regime continued to bombard them with heavy artillery and rockets from ground launchers. ACU worked on documenting the regime's breach of the ceasefire. As of the date of preparing this report, the Syrian regime and its Russian ally have violated the ceasefire **3**,139 times.



After the ceasefire came into effect, **Turkish and Russian forces began conducting joint military patrols** on the contact lines between the regime forces and the opposition forces, as these patrols run along the M4 international road. These joint forces aim to monitor the implementation of the ceasefire and de-escalation on the contact lines. However, **Russian forces stopped participating in these natrols** in mid-September 2020

In the central region of Idlib governorate, on 11 May 2022, Russian warplanes targeted the vicinity of Shannan and Binnin towns with several airstrikes. On 12 May 2022, Russian warplanes targeted a poultry farm on the outskirts of Montef town with several airstrikes, injuring a civilian and killing a large number of poultry. The Russian warplanes also bombed Kafr Lata and Ma'arzaf towns with several airstrikes. In the western countryside of Aleppo, regime forces targeted a child with machine guns near of al-Wasita town, injuring him. In the northern countryside of Aleppo, on 13 May 2022, Russian warplanes targeted Kafr Janneh town with five airstrikes, injuring two civilians. On 12 May 2022, the so-called Syrian Democratic Forces (SDF) bombed the cities of al-Bab and Jarablus with heavy artillery, injuring a civilian and a child in Jarablus city. SDF rocketed Mari' city from ground launchers, injuring two children. Also, SDF targeted Mash'alah town in Sharan sub-district with heavy artillery.



In the city of ar-Raqqa, In the eastern countryside of Aleppo, on 12 May 2022, a landmine exploded near 'On al-Dadat town, injuring two civilians.

In the eastern countryside of Deir ez-Zor, On 9 May 2022, the Coalition Forces carried out an airdrop operation in Shuhayl town, and the Coalition Forces addressed the inhabitants of the house via loudspeakers to surrender themselves. No resistance was heard from the inhabitants of the house who had surrendered to the International Coalition, and it was not known how many were arrested or why. On 12 May 2022, the so-called Syrian Democratic Forces (SDF) increased the number of their checkpoints at the entrances of Abu Al-Nitel village after an exchange of fire between an SDF patrol and a villager during their seizure of his motorcycle. The clash resulted in the injury of a girl, a woman being in a critical condition, and the death of an SDF fighter.

In the northern countryside of al-Hasakah, On 14 May 2022, in the northern countryside of al-Hasakah, the so-called Syrian Democratic Forces (SDF) fired a guided missile at a civilian vehicle in the Ra's al-Ayn sub-district, injuring a civilian.

The US administration announced the exemption of companies from investment sanctions in the fields of agriculture and construction in eastern Syria within the territories under the control of the so-called Syrian Democratic Forces SDF, so that American and European companies can invest in eastern Syria without being affected by the sanctions imposed on the Syrian regime.
