



NORTHEAST AND NORTHWEST 15-21 April; 2022

3,087 violations of truce committed by the Regime and its Russian ally

After the Turkey and Russia reached a ceasefire agreement in Idlib governorate on March 5, 2020, the Syrian regime and its Russian ally did not bomb northwest Syria with warplanes. However, the regime continued to bomb these cities and towns with heavy artillery and rockets from ground launchers. On June 2, 2020, Russian warplanes resumed bombing cities and towns in northwest Syria, and the regime continued to bombard them with heavy artillery and rockets from ground launchers. Through its network of enumerators, ACU worked on documenting the regime's breach of the ceasefire. As of the date of preparing this report, the Syrian regime and its Russian ally have violated the ceasefire 3,087 times.



After the ceasefire came into effect, Turkish and Russian forces began conducting joint military patrols on the contact lines between the regime forces and the opposition forces, as these patrols run along the M4 international road. These joint forces aim to monitor the implementation of the ceasefire and de-escalation on the contact lines. However, Russian forces stopped participating in these patrols in mid-September 2020.










In the northern countryside of Aleppo, on 17 April 2022, an IED planted in a car exploded in Qabbasin town, killing a civilian. The so-called Syrian Democratic Forces (SDF) shelled the outskirts of Jarablus city with two shells, killing two civilians and causing a third to go missing on the banks of the Euphrates River. On 18 April 2022, three Free Civil Defense volunteers were injured near Jarablus city as a result of artillery shelling by SDF, targeting the Civil Defense volunteers while searching for a person who had been missing after SDF's shelling on the previous day.

Chemonics's education sector's support contracts (the Manahel Program) expired by the end of April 2022, and support in the new contracts will be reduced by more than 60%, as only 40% of the current grant will be available, and the focus will be on aspects of the psychological support at the expense of salary support for the educational staff. This will constitute a major crisis in the education sector in Idlib governorate as a result of suspending salary support for the majority of teachers.

In the northern countryside of ar-Raqqa, on 15 April 2022, the regime forces prevented 18 trucks carrying goods from leaving their areas of control to the areas controlled by the so-called Syrian Democratic Forces (SDF). The regime forces forced the trucks to return to the governorates of Aleppo and Idlib. The denial of trucks to enter came after the siege imposed by SDF on the regime-controlled areas in al-Hasakeh governorate. During the current week, 12 male and female teachers were dismissed by SDF on charges of inciting teachers against SDF's self-administration in ar-Raqqa governorate, after participating in what teachers in militia-run schools call the "Dignity Strike", to demand an increase in their salaries. It is noteworthy that thousands of teachers staged a strike in the SDF-controlled areas and called it the "Dignity Strike," which began in Deir ez-Zor on April 8, 2022, after staging a number of strikes in the cities and towns of the region. After that, the teachers of ar-Raqqa, Manbij, and several education assemblies south of al-Hasakeh joined the strike to demand an increase in teachers' salaries, which amount to 260 thousand Syrian pounds only, to which SDF responded by threats and accusations of loyalty to foreign entities.

in the northern countryside of al-Hasakah, On 19 April 2022, a group of revolutionary youths (Jwanin Shorshkar) affiliated with the PKK burned down the Kurdistan Democratic Party's office in ad-Derbasiyah. An Iraqi refugee woman was killed in al-Hol camp with the bullets of an unknown person. Two dead bodies of women were also found in the camp. The Coalition forces carried out an airdrop operation targeting a residential neighborhood in Markada city, which resulted in a number of persons being arrested without knowing the reasons. On 20 April 2022, inter-clan fighting took place between the Bani Sab'a and the al-Bou Najm clans in Abu Dhwail town, south of al-Qamishli town, killing 6 people and injuring 3 on both sides.
