



# 3,253 violations of truce committed by the Regime and its Russian ally

After the Turkey and Russia reached a **ceasefire agreement** in Idlib governorate on March 5, 2020, the Syrian regime and its Russian ally did not bomb northwest Syria with warplanes. However, the regime continued to bomb these cities and towns with heavy artillery and rockets from ground launchers. On June 2, 2020, Russian warplanes resumed bombing cities and towns in northwest Syria, and the regime continued to bombard them with heavy artillery and rockets from ground launchers. Through its network of enumerators, ACU worked on documenting the regime's breach of the ceasefire. As of the date of preparing this report, the Syrian regime and its Russian ally have violated the ceasefire 3,253 times.



After the ceasefire came into effect, Turkish and Russian forces began conducting joint military patrols on the contact lines between the regime forces and the opposition forces, as these patrols run along the M4 international road. These joint forces aim to monitor the implementation of the ceasefire and de-escalation on the contact lines. However, Russian forces stopped participating in these patrols in mid-September 2020.








Result of the hostilities of the regime and its allies in northwest Syria



Result of the hostilities of the Regime and its allies in northwest Syria


IIn northwest Syria: 1 IED exploded, injuring 1 civilian.

In northwest Syria camps: 6 accidents resulted in the burning of 6 tents and the injury of 2 displaced persons

In the central area of Idlib governorate, on 8 July 2022, regime forces shelled Balyon town with heavy artillery, injuring a civilian. On 12 July 2022, Russian warplanes bombed Balshon town with several airstrikes.

In northwest Syria, 30 traffic accidents occurred during Eid al-Adha days (4 days), killing 3 civilians and injuring 52 civilians, including 15 children and 11 women. Information sources confirm that the main causes of traffic accidents are excessive speed by the drivers, the absence of any authority controlling traffic, the absence of traffic signals or signs to provide drivers with road information and speed limits, and the absence of any authority supervising the annual inspection of the vehicles and ensuring their readiness to function properly.

#### **Northeast Syria**



On 10 July 2022, in the northern countryside of al-Hasakah, the body of a man was found dead in Sector 3 of al-Hol camp. On 11 July 2022, a young man in Shareek town in al-Darbasiyah sub-district committed suicide by shooting himself. Information sources confirm that the young man was suffering from psychological disorders.
