



# violations of truce committed by the Regime and its Russian ally

After the Turkey and Russia reached a ceasefire agreement in Idlib governorate on March 5, 2020, the Syrian regime and its Russian ally did not bomb northwest Syria with warplanes. However, the regime continued to bomb these cities and towns with heavy artillery and rockets from ground launchers. On June 2, 2020, Russian warplanes resumed bombing cities and towns in northwest Syria, and the regime continued to bombard them with heavy artillery and rockets from ground launchers. Through its network of enumerators, ACU worked on documenting the regime's breach of the ceasefire. As of the date of preparing this report, the Syrian regime and its Russian ally have violated the ceasefire 3.458 times.



After the ceasefire came into effect, Turkish and Russian forces began conducting joint military patrols on the contact lines between the regime forces and the opposition forces, as these patrols run along the M4 international road. These joint forces aim to monitor the implementation of the ceasefire and de-escalation on the contact lines. However, Russian forces stopped participating in these patrols in mid-September 2020.









Result of the hostilities of the regime and its allies in northwest Syria



In the camps of northwest Syria In Northwest Syria camps, 7 incidents led to the burning of 9 tents.

In northwestern Syria


2 IEDs detonated, killing 2 civilians and injuring another.

On 16 August 2022, regime forces bombarded with heavy artillery the town of Ftireh in the southern countryside of Idleb, killing two civilians and wounding another who were harvesting the fig crop. Ten civilians, including 2 women, were injured in 6 traffic accidents in various governorate areas.

On 18 August 2022, the regime forces bombarded with artillery the towns of Kadoura, Ruwayha and Manatif, wounding 2 civilians in the town of Kadoura and two civilians in Manatif. A mine exploded in the vicinity of the town of Bara, killing one civilian and wounding another.

On 19 August 2022, the city of Al-Bab in the northern countryside of Aleppo came under rocket fire from ground launchers, killing 13 civilians and wounding 38 others. Information sources confirmed that the rocket sources are areas that are jointly controlled by the Syrian Democratic Forces (SDF) and the regime forces.

On 20 August 2022, a sniper from the regime forces targeted a civilian near the Tadaf roundabout in the city of Al-Bab, killing him.



On 16 August 2022, an International Coalition base near Omar Oilfield (adjacent to the town of Thiban) in the eastern countryside of Deir ez-Zor came under fire from several rockets, some of which did not explode.

In the eastern countryside of Aleppo, Turkish drones bombed a joint military position for the regime forces and the so-called Syrian Democratic Forces (SDF) on a hill near the town of Jraqli, west of the city of Ain Al Arab. 20 members of the regime forces were killed in the shelling. In the northern countryside of Ar-Raqqa, a military column of the regime forces entered Tabaqa Airbase.
