

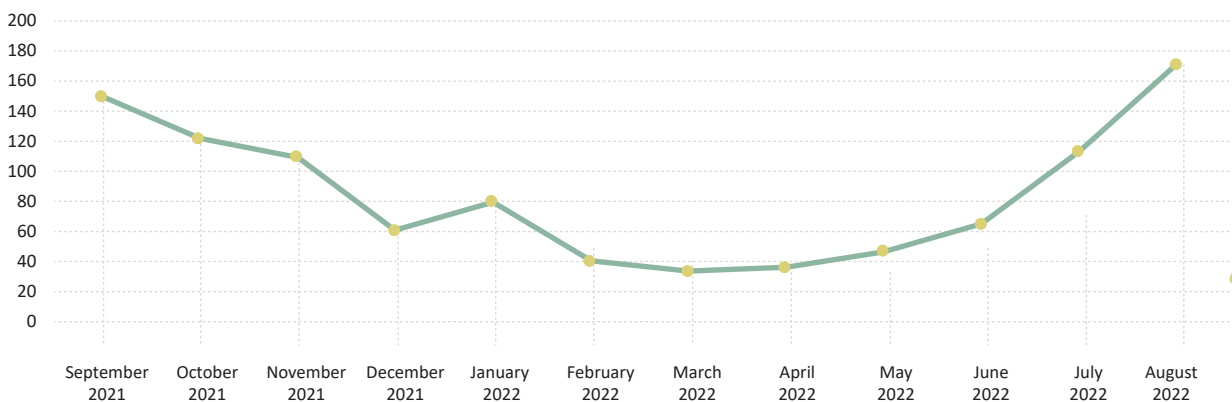

NORTHEAST AND NORTHWEST 22-31 August; 2022

3,557 violations of truce committed by the Regime and its Russian ally

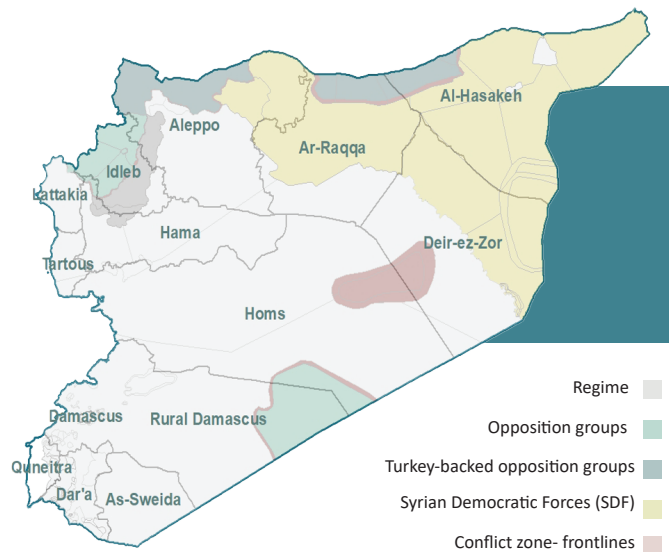
After the Turkey and Russia reached a **ceasefire agreement** in Idlib governorate on March 5, 2020, the Syrian regime and its Russian ally did not bomb northwest Syria with warplanes. However, the **regime continued to bomb** these cities and towns **with heavy artillery and rockets** from ground launchers. On June 2, 2020, **Russian warplanes resumed bombing** cities and towns in northwest Syria, and the regime continued to bombard them with heavy artillery and rockets from ground launchers. Through its network of enumerators, **ACU worked on documenting the regime's breach of the ceasefire**. As of the date of preparing this report, the Syrian regime and its Russian ally have violated the ceasefire **3,557 times**.

Violations of the truce committed by the Regime last year



After the ceasefire came into effect, **Turkish and Russian forces began conducting joint military patrols** on the contact lines between the regime forces and the opposition forces, as these patrols run along the M4 international road. These joint forces aim to monitor the implementation of the ceasefire and de-escalation on the contact lines. However, **Russian forces stopped participating in these patrols** in mid-September 2020.

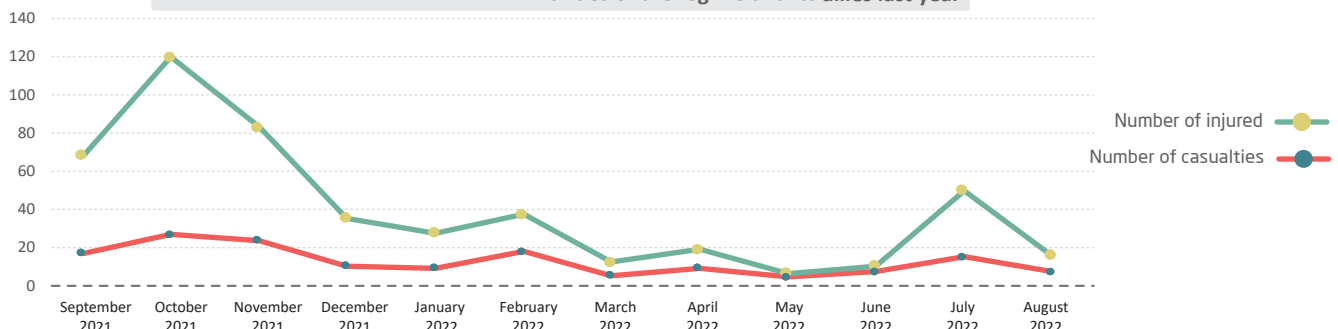

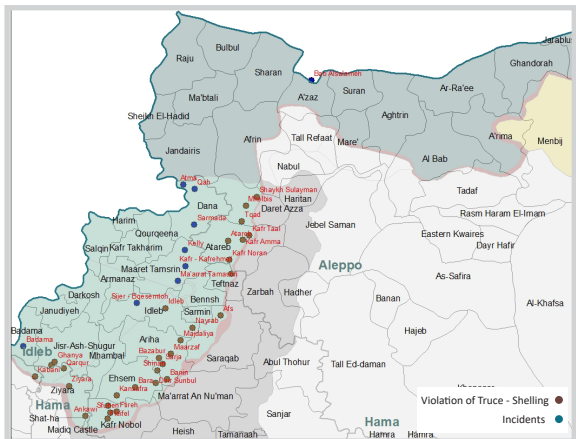


Result of the hostilities of the regime and its allies in northwest Syria

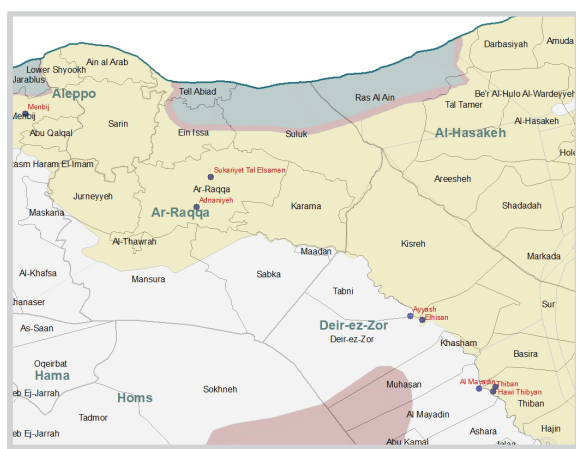
Result of the hostilities of the Regime and its allies in northwest Syria

In the camps of northwest Syria 11 incidents led to burning 14 tents.

In northwestern Syria one IED exploded which led to injuring 3 civilians.

In the central region of Idlib governorate, on 22 August 2022, Russian warplanes bombed the area around Idlib Prison with eight airstrikes in the west of Idlib city. In the western countryside of Idlib, in the city of Badama, a young man committed suicide by shooting himself.

Northeast Syria



In the eastern countryside of Aleppo, on 23 August 2022, a five-car delegation of the International Coalition (US-British) entered the city of Manbij, where the delegation was seen entering the military base of the so-called Syrian Democratic Forces (SDF) - in Manbij mills and the headquarters of the Civil Council of SDF in the city center. On 26 August 2022, SDF released all the students they had arrested for conscription during the past period through their checkpoints and prevented them from going to the regime areas to attend their exams. 108 secondary school certificate and university students had been released.

In the countryside of Deir Ez-Zor, on 24 August 2022, the international coalition forces stationed at Al-Tanf base shelled Ayyash military base, which is run by the Fatemiyoun militia related to Iran. The US Central Command confirmed its target responsibility and stated that it was necessary to protect the Americans. International Coalition aircraft carried out several airstrikes on Iranian militia positions near Mayadeen city. Iranian militias fired missiles from ground launchers at Al-Omar oilfield, where the international coalition forces are stationed, and at Zeban city. On 25 August 2022, United States helicopters carried out airstrikes on Iranian militia positions in Al-Hawi area and Al-Irashadiyah school near Al-Mayadeen city.

In the northern countryside of Al-Raqqqa, on 26 August 2022, Al-Raqqqa Civil Council of the so-called Syrian Democratic Forces (SDF) began work on establishing a new camp north Al-Adnaniyah village in the western countryside of Al-Raqqqa, where the new camp will accommodate all the 58 random camps in the countryside of Al-Raqqqa. The Social Affairs and Labor Committee in the civil council of Al-Raqqqa stated that the project aims to control and organize about 16,000 families living in random camps within 58 camps in the countryside of Al-Raqqqa. Unknown assailants targeted with light arms a Russian patrol on its way to a military base north of Tall Al-Samn town.

In the countryside of Quneitra governorate, on 24 August 2022, unknown assailants targeted a Russian patrol with an IED near Al-Mala'kah town- without any information on any injuries sustained by the patrol members. In the western countryside of Dara 'a, on 25 August 2022, regime forces raided the house of a dissident colonel in the city of Nawa (Fawaz al-Tayasneh) in search of his son to arrest him. The raid resulted in the injury of Colonel Fawaz. Moreover, the regime forces also carried out a campaign of arrests in the southern neighborhoods of Nawa city, where several civilians were wounded. The southern districts of Nawa city also had clashes between residents of the districts and the regime forces, where many elements of the regime forces were killed. The regime forces raided the town of Mliha and arrested two nomadic tribe members after they were run over by a military vehicle.
