



NORTHEAST AND NORTHWEST 8-14 November; 2022

4.022 violations of truce committed by the Regime and its Russian ally

After the Turkey and Russia reached a **ceasefire agreement** in Idlib governorate on March 5, 2020, the Syrian regime and its Russian ally did not bomb northwest Syria with warplanes. However, the regime continued to bomb these cities and towns with heavy artillery and rockets from ground launchers. On June 2, 2020, Russian warplanes resumed bombing cities and towns in northwest Syria, and the regime continued to bombard them with heavy artillery and rockets from ground launchers. Through its network of enumerators, ACU worked on documenting the regime's breach of the ceasefire. As of the date of preparing this report, the Syrian regime and its Russian ally have violated the ceasefire 4,022 times.



After the ceasefire came into effect, Turkish and Russian forces began conducting joint military patrols on the contact lines between the regime forces and the opposition forces, as these patrols run along the M4 international road. These joint forces aim to monitor the implementation of the ceasefire and de-escalation on the contact lines. However, Russian forces stopped participating in these patrols in mid-September 2020.









Result of the hostilities of the regime and its allies in northwest Syria

Number of victims as a result of the hostilities of theRegime and its allies last year



Result of the hostilities of the Regime and its allies in northwest Syria

In Northwest Syria camps,

5 accidents led to the burning of 7 tents.

In the central area of Idleb governorate, on 14 November 2022, regime forces shelled with heavy artillery the towns of Maarbalit and Maarzaf, killing two civilians working in the olive harvest. The regime forces bombarded with heavy artillery the towns of San, Maarbalit, Bara, Hallubi, Ruwaiha, and Maaret Elnaasan. In the southern countryside of Idleb, regime forces shelled the city of Daret Azza with heavy artillery. A young man in the city of Ehsem, aged 21, committed suicide by taking a poisonous pill (Aluminum Phosphide tablet).

Northeast Syria Tal Ta Deir-ez-Zor

In the eastern countryside of Deir ez-Zor, on 9 November 2002, unidentified drones attacked a column of trucks of unknown cargo near the Al Qaim crossing in the city of Abu Kamal. The drones also attacked a column of fuel tankers accompanied by Lebanese Hezbollah forces. The crossing witnesses constant targeting of fuel tankers and trucks. Information sources confirm that Iranian and Hezbollah militias use the crossing to transport weapons, often concealing weapons within the fuel tankers, building materials, or foodstuffs.
