

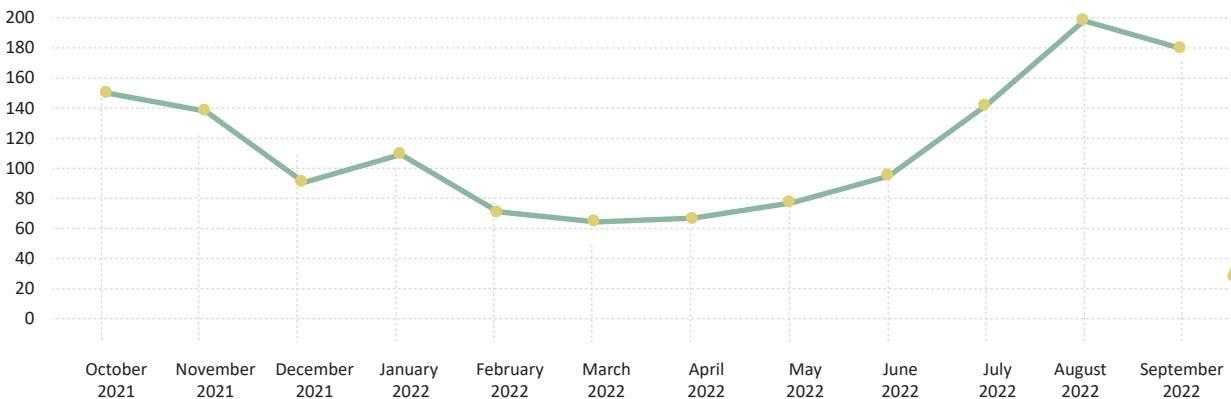

NORTHEAST AND NORTHWEST 8-14 October; 2022

3,833 violations of truce committed by the Regime and its Russian ally

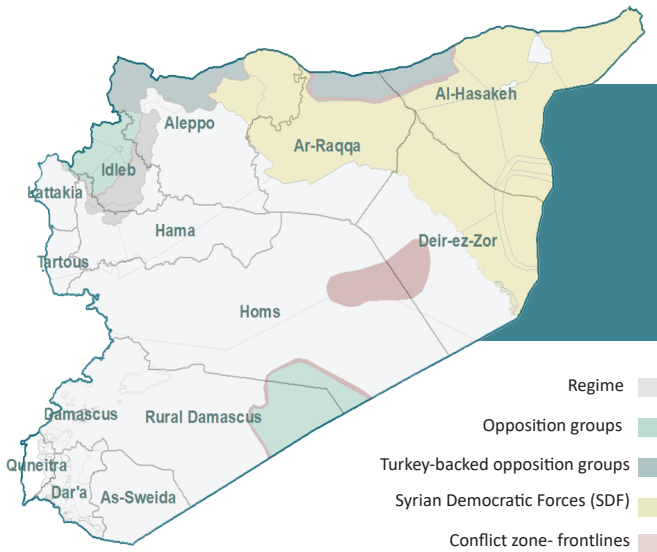
After the Turkey and Russia reached a **ceasefire agreement** in Idlib governorate on March 5, 2020, the Syrian regime and its Russian ally did not bomb northwest Syria with warplanes. However, the **regime continued to bomb** these cities and towns **with heavy artillery and rockets** from ground launchers. On June 2, 2020, **Russian warplanes resumed bombing** cities and towns in northwest Syria, and the regime continued to bombard them with heavy artillery and rockets from ground launchers. Through its network of enumerators, **ACU worked on documenting the regime's breach of the ceasefire**. As of the date of preparing this report, the Syrian regime and its Russian ally have violated the ceasefire 3,833 times.

Violations of the truce committed by the Regime last year



After the ceasefire came into effect, **Turkish and Russian forces began conducting joint military patrols** on the contact lines between the regime forces and the opposition forces, as these patrols run along the M4 international road. These joint forces aim to monitor the implementation of the ceasefire and de-escalation on the contact lines. However, **Russian forces stopped participating in these patrols** in mid-September 2020.

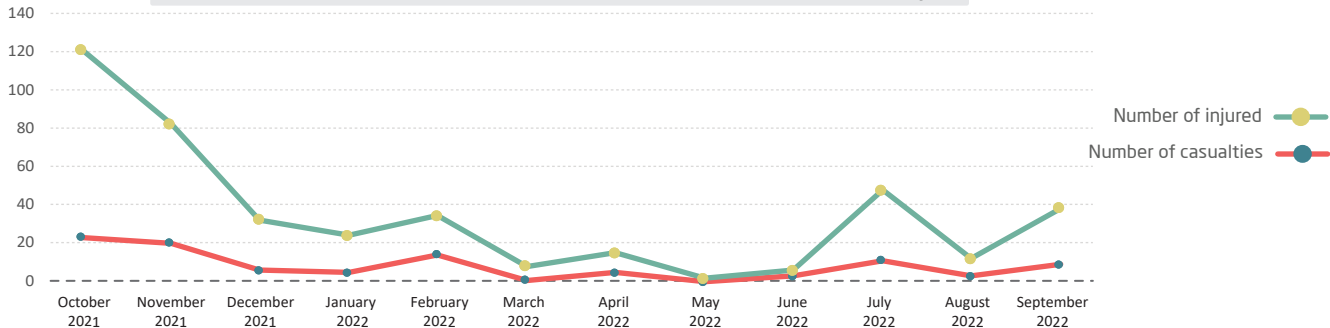

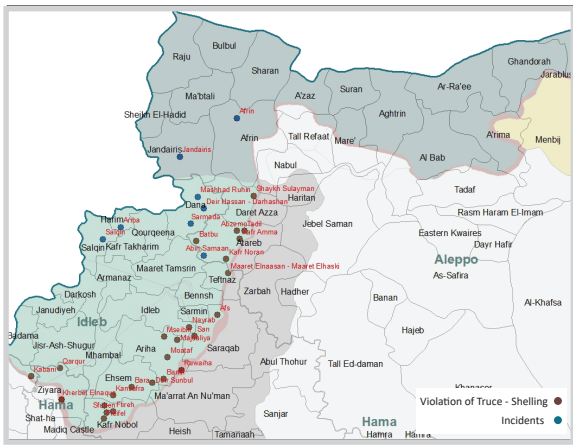


Result of the hostilities of the regime and its allies in northwest Syria

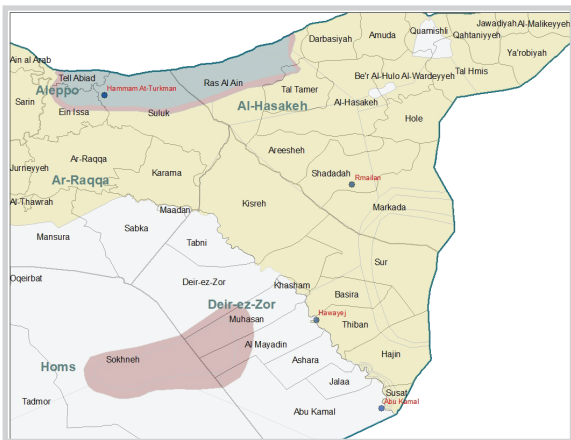
Result of the hostilities of the Regime and its allies in northwest Syria

In the camps of northwest Syria
6 incidents led to the burning of 8 tents.

In the western countryside of Aleppo, on 10 October 2022, regime forces shelled with heavy artillery the vicinity of Al-Muhsin camp (Kafr Nobol) in the town of Batbu, causing damage to some of the IDPs' tents. The regime forces also shelled the town of Abzemo, killing a 17-year-old child and a woman. In the western countryside of Idleb, on 11 October 2022, Russian warplanes carried out several air strikes on a poultry house in Zuainiah, destroying the town and killing all the poultry. In the north-western countryside of Hama, Russian warplanes bombed the town of Qarqur with several air strikes.

In the northern countryside of Aleppo, on 12 October 2022, clashes took place between opposition factions in the Jandairis area, which led to the displacement of several camp residents in the Afrin area and the town of Atmeh. The fighting began after accusations were made against Hamza Division fighters in the killing of a media activist in the city of Al Bab, which led to the mobilization of the Third Legion, of which the Levant Front is its backbone, to dismantle the Hamza Division and take control of the city of Al Bab. The clashes escalated after the arrival of the Amshat faction (The Suleyman Shah Union) in support of the Hamza Division against the Third Legion. Then, the forces of HTS military columns to support the Amshat and Hamza factions against the Third Legion. The clashes led to the cutting off of all roads between Idleb Governorate and Afrin region, the death of 2 displaced women and one child, and the injury of 28 displaced people, including five women. On 14 October 2022, the conflicting factions, represented by HTS and the Third Legion, reached a ceasefire agreement. However, the Third Legion revoked the agreement immediately after it was published on social networking sites. Leaders from the Third Legion, especially from Jaysh al-Islam, refused the agreement, which led to the recurrence of shelling and clashes in the vicinity of Kafr Janna. These clashes and shelling were described as the most violent since the beginning of the dispute. The Interim Government stated that there were no armed manifestations in the city of Afrin and that the Interim Government civilian police supervised all security aspects within the city. On 13 October 2022, the so-called Syrian Democratic Forces (SDF) shelled Kuwait al-Rahma camp near Afrin, killing two displaced persons and injuring 3.

Northeast Syria



In the northern countryside of Al-Hasakeh, on 8 October 2022, an IC military base in the city of Rmeilan was targeted by unidentified missiles, and the attack did not result in any casualties. On 11 October 2022, the International Coalition dispatched in Syria more than 100 trucks carrying weapons, ammunition, and logistical supplies, as well as sophisticated rockets, weapons, and tank carriers, to the bases of the United States forces deployed in northern Syria.

In the eastern countryside of Aleppo, on 10 October 2022, the so-called Syrian Democratic Forces (SDF) raided the village of Awn Dadat in the north of the city of Menbij, arresting 16 young men on charges of smuggling and dealing with the national army (the opposition forces in northern Aleppo). During the arrests, clashes took place with the people. The clashes resulted in the injury of seven SDF members and the death of two people from the village, after which SDF imposed a curfew on the village and prevented the people from entering and leaving the village.

In the eastern countryside of Deir ez-Zor, on 10 October 2022, two IRGC locations were shelled by unidentified aircraft near Imam Ali Air Base in the south of Abu Kamal city, as the IRGC uses the location as a weapons depot, and the second location is within Abu Kamal city. On 13 October 2022, the International Coalition forces, in cooperation with the so-called Syrian Democratic Forces (SDF), conducted an airdrop operation in the town of Hawayej Sharqi, which resulted in the arrest of a person with disabilities.

In the northern countryside of Ar-Raqqa, on 10 October 2022, IC aircraft bombed a motorcycle rider in Hammam At-Turkman with three rockets, killing him..
