

violations of truce committed by the Regime and its Russian ally

After the Turkey and Russia reached a ceasefire agreement in Idlib governorate on March 5, 2020, the Syrian regime and its Russian ally did not bomb northwest Syria with warplanes. However, the regime continued to bomb these cities and towns with heavy artillery and rockets from ground launchers. On June 2, 2020, Russian warplanes resumed bombing cities and towns in northwest Syria, and the regime continued to bombard them with heavy artillery and rockets from ground launchers. Through its network of enumerators, ACU worked on documenting the regime's breach of the ceasefire. As of the date of preparing this report, the Syrian regime and its Russian ally have violated the ceasefire 3.642 times.



After the ceasefire came into effect, Turkish and Russian forces began conducting joint military patrols on the contact lines between the regime forces and the opposition forces, as these patrols run along the M4 international road. These joint forces aim to monitor the implementation of the ceasefire and de-escalation on the contact lines. However, Russian forces stopped participating in these patrols in mid-September 2020.





Controlling Parties 14 september 2022





In the central region of Idleb governorate, on 8 September 2022, Russian warplanes bombed several air strikes on Sheikh Yousef and Hafasraja, killing 7 and wounding 12 civilians.

In the northern countryside of Aleppo, on 12 September 2022, the head of the local council and the Head of the Chamber of Commerce and Industry received several Syrian and Arab investors in the new building of the Chamber of Commerce and Industry in Al-Bab, in the presence of representatives of the Syrian Interim Government, traders and industrialists, and representatives of farmers in Al-Bab. During the meeting, the delegation was briefed on the investment opportunities and possibilities available in Al-Bab area and ways of cooperating to establish investment projects that contribute to providing new job opportunities for young people in the region.



In the northern countryside of Al-Hasakeh, on 12 September 2022, a motorcycle bomb exploded in Tweineh camp near the city of Al-Hasakeh, killing three civilians.

This year, the area of cotton crop cultivation in eastern Syria (Jazira) was more than 160 thousand acres, according to the Directorate of Plant Production in Jazira region of the so-called Syrian Democratic Forces SDF. The Directorate confirmed that the cotton harvest is good this year and free of insect infections, except for small areas that will not affect production in general. SDF opened 3 centers to receive the crops from farmers in Al-Hasakeh, Raqqa, and Deir ez-Zor, and set the price of 1 kilogram of cotton at 4,300 Syrian pounds. Information sources confirm a decrease in green areas in the Syrian Jazira area, considered the food basket in Syria. These areas have decreased due to the decline in rainfall annually and the high costs of irrigation agriculture. However, serious concern remains about the occurrence of an environmental and food disaster, considering groundwater and wells consumption indicators in the region.
