



NORTHEAST AND NORTHWEST 01-07 December; 2022

violations of truce committed by the Regime and its Russian ally

After the Turkey and Russia reached a ceasefire agreement in Idlib governorate on March 5, 2020, the Syrian regime and its Russian ally did not bomb northwest Syria with warplanes. However, the regime continued to bomb these cities and towns with heavy artillery and rockets from ground launchers. On June 2, 2020, Russian warplanes resumed bombing cities and towns in northwest Syria, and the regime continued to bombard them with heavy artillery and rockets from ground launchers. Through its network of enumerators, ACU worked on documenting the regime's breach of the ceasefire. As of the date of preparing this report, the Syrian regime and its Russian ally have violated the ceasefire 4.120 times.



After the ceasefire came into effect, Turkish and Russian forces began conducting joint military patrols on the contact lines between the regime forces and the opposition forces, as these patrols run along the M4 international road. These joint forces aim to monitor the implementation of the ceasefire and de-escalation on the contact lines. However, Russian forces stopped participating in these patrols in mid-September 2020.









Result of the hostilities of the regime and its allies in northwest Syria


Controlling Parties 07 December 2022



Number of victims as a result of the hostilities of the Regime and its allies last year



Result of the hostilities of the Regime and its allies in northwest Syria


In the camps of northwestern Syria, five accidents led to the burning of 6 tents and the injury of 3 IDPs.

In northwest Syria, 3 IEDs exploded, Killing a civilian and injuring two civilians.

On 2 December 2022, regime forces hit a civilian house in the western countryside of Idleb, killing three civilians and wounding six.

In the northern countryside of Ar-Raqqa on 1 December 2022, SDF forces bombarded the city of Tell Abiad, killing three civilians, including a child. Turkish drone aircraft bombed SDF positions in the vicinity of Ein Issa city. On 2 December 2022, SDF forces shelled the town of Al-Tuffaha in Ein Issa sub-district, killing two civilians and one child. On 4 December 2022, SDF and its customs killed one young man, and another managed to escape as the two men were smuggling items near the southern Tabaqa crossing with the regime. The area today is active in cultivating agricultural lands and seeds in Al-Thawra (Tabaqa) after the rains that fell at the beginning of winter. However, the cultivation of lands was accompanied by long-standing disagreements over land ownership that reappeared during this period. Young people from the Nasser clan shot an agricultural tractor driver to prevent him from cultivating his land in the village of Sefsafa and damaged his tractor. On 6 December 2022, a fire broke out in a school in Tal Elsamen camp, killing two children and injuring five.

In the northern countryside of Al-Hasakeh, on 1 December 2022, Turkish forces canceled a plan of a joint patrol with Russian forces in the Darbasiyah sub-district. Turkish forces shelled the town of Kozliyeh, in Tal Tamer sub-district, with heavy artillery. On 2 December 2022, Turkish forces shelled SDF positions in the town of Kozliyeh with heavy artillery. The international coalition resumed joint patrols with the SDF in northeastern Syria. Two patrols exited the Rmeilan military base in two different directions. The rainstorm damaged a group of tents in Rojava camp in the Al-Malikeyyeh sub-district countryside. On 6 December 2022, a United States patrol was blocked and prevented from crossing by a regime checkpoint in the village of Khweilid in the Be'r Al-Hulo Al-Wardeyyeh sub-district.



In the eastern countryside of Deir ez-Zor on 2 December 2022, SDF raided a civilian's home in the town of Shiheil to arrest him, but the patrol bullets killed the young man instead of being arrested.

In As-Sweida governorate, on 4 December 2022, regime forces fired live bullets at civilians demonstrating, killing two civilians and injuring 15.

Media channels reported that Washington asked Turkey to re-examine the possible military operation in Turkey. At the same time, Turkey met with Washington demanding the fulfilling of its commitments regarding the security of the Turkish borders and the removal of the Syrian Democratic Forces (SDF). According to the Reuters channel, SDF announced the cancellation of coordination with the international coalition after the Turkish bombardment that targeted its areas.
