

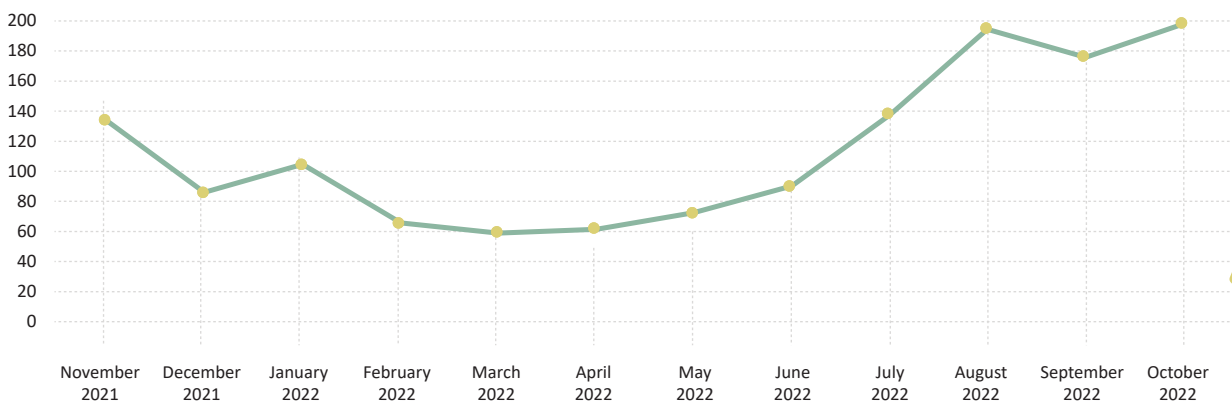

NORTHEAST AND NORTHWEST 15-21 November; 2022

4,066 violations of truce committed by the Regime and its Russian ally

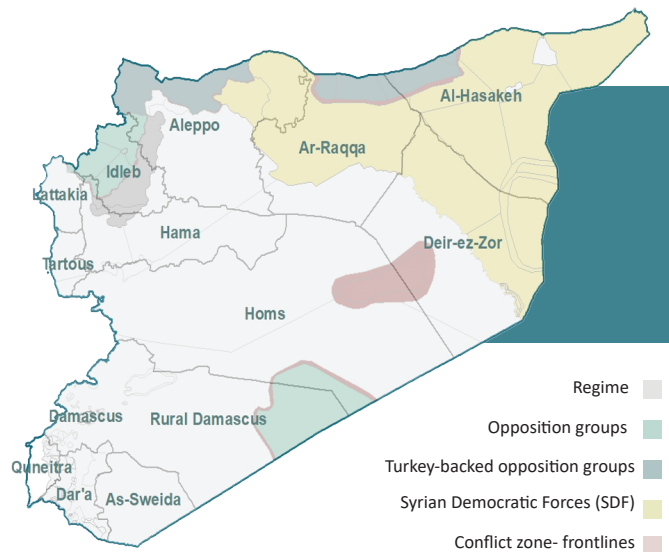
After the Turkey and Russia reached a **ceasefire agreement** in Idlib governorate on March 5, 2020, the Syrian regime and its Russian ally did not bomb northwest Syria with warplanes. However, the **regime continued to bomb** these cities and towns **with heavy artillery and rockets** from ground launchers. On June 2, 2020, **Russian warplanes resumed bombing** cities and towns in northwest Syria, and the regime continued to bombard them with heavy artillery and rockets from ground launchers. Through its network of enumerators, **ACU worked on documenting the regime's breach of the ceasefire**. As of the date of preparing this report, the Syrian regime and its Russian ally have violated the ceasefire **4,066 times**.

Violations of the truce committed by the Regime last year



After the ceasefire came into effect, **Turkish and Russian forces began conducting joint military patrols** on the contact lines between the regime forces and the opposition forces, as these patrols run along the M4 international road. These joint forces aim to monitor the implementation of the ceasefire and de-escalation on the contact lines. However, **Russian forces stopped participating in these patrols** in mid-September 2020.

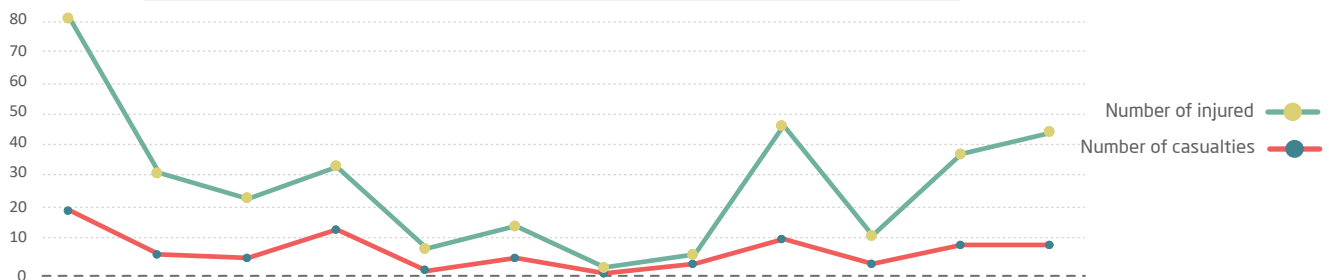

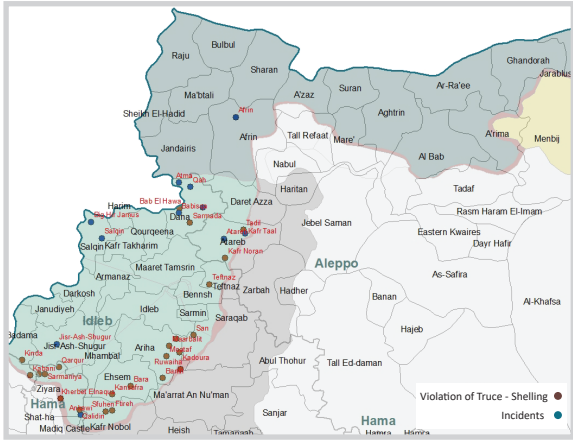


Result of the hostilities of the regime and its allies in northwest Syria

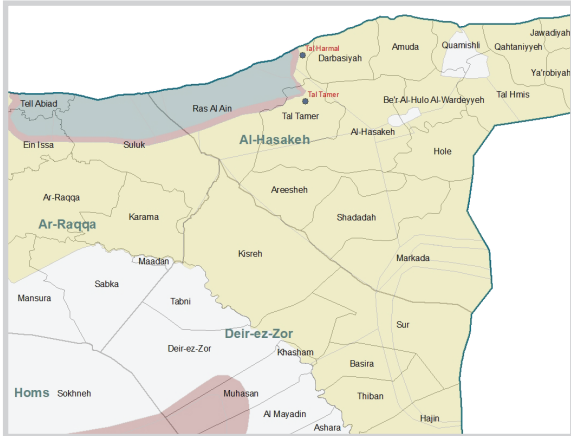
Result of the hostilities of the Regime and its allies in northwest Syria

In the camps of northwestern Syria, 8 incidents led to the burning of 6 tents, the flooding of 8 tents, and the injury of an IDP.

In northwest Syria, 3 IEDs exploded, killing 2 and injuring 3 civilians.

In the western countryside of Aleppo, on 17 November 2022, regime forces shelled the city of Atareb with heavy artillery, injuring 6 civilians, including two children. In the northern countryside of Idlib, on 21 November 2022, Russian warplanes launched several air raids in the vicinity of medical clinics near the Bab Al-Hawa border crossing, and Russian warplanes launched several air raids in the town of Sarmada. In the central area of Idlib governorate, the Russian air force bombarded the town of Babisqa with several air strikes. In the western countryside of Idlib, Russian warplanes bombed the town of Kinda with several air strikes. In the northern countryside of Lattakia, the regime forces carried out several air strikes on the hill of Kabani.

Northeast Syria



In the countryside of Al-Hasakeh Governorate, the areas cultivated with wheat and barley crops to date amounted to about 9 thousand hectares in various agricultural stability areas. This is a result of the agricultural sub-plan in the governorate. The head of the Directorate of Plant Production in Al-Hasakeh Agriculture Directorate stated that the area cultivated with the irrigated wheat crop amounted to 3,530 hectares, and rain-fed wheat 2,320 hectares. As for irrigated barley, the cultivated area amounted to 325 hectares, and rain-fed barley was 2,750 hectares, indicating that the cultivation operations were concentrated in the southern and eastern regions and the countryside of Al-Hasakeh, especially the area of Tal Brak. The Head of the Plant Production Directorate pointed out that the farming operations that usually continue until the beginning of next year will increase successively, especially the rain-fed areas of wheat and barley crops, in light of the farmers' engagement in agriculture after the good rainfall that took place throughout the governorate during the current month. Notably, the plan to cultivate irrigated wheat in Al-Hasakeh governorate amounts to 290,632 hectares, rain-fed wheat 424,124 hectares, irrigated barley 28,250 hectares, and rain-fed barley 274,839 hectares.

In camps in north-western Syria, on 16 November 2022, There were heavy winds and floods in the Andalus camp of the town of Qah in the northern countryside of Idlib, resulting in the injury of a civilian and the destruction of a tent. Also, there were severe winds and floods in the Jan Afrin camp of the city of Afrin in the northern countryside of Aleppo, resulting in the destruction of seven tents.
