

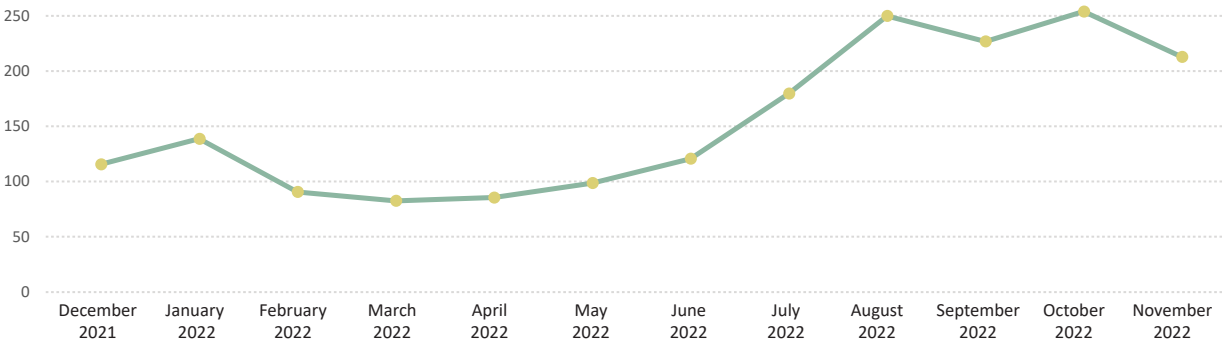

NORTHEAST AND NORTHWEST 22-30 November; 2022

4,101 violations of truce committed by the Regime and its Russian ally

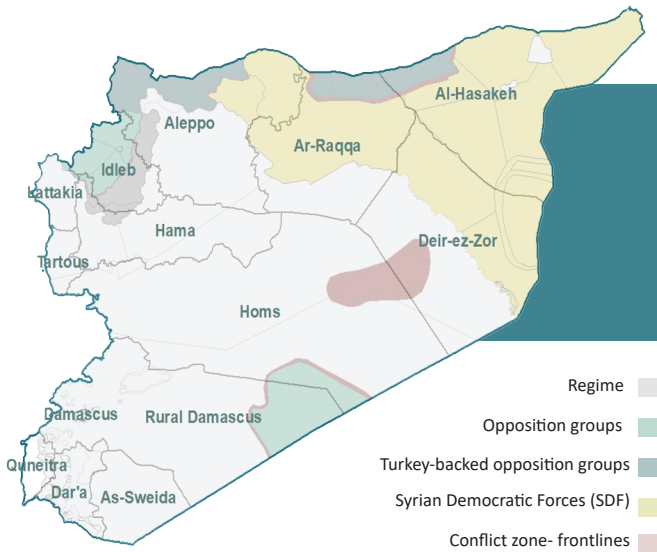
After the Turkey and Russia reached a ceasefire agreement in Idlib governorate on March 5, 2020, the Syrian regime and its Russian ally did not bomb northwest Syria with warplanes. However, the regime continued to bomb these cities and towns with heavy artillery and rockets from ground launchers. On June 2, 2020, Russian warplanes resumed bombing cities and towns in northwest Syria, and the regime continued to bombard them with heavy artillery and rockets from ground launchers. Through its network of enumerators, ACU worked on documenting the regime's breach of the ceasefire. As of the date of preparing this report, the Syrian regime and its Russian ally have violated the ceasefire 4,101 times.

Violations of the truce committed by the Regime last year



After the ceasefire came into effect, Turkish and Russian forces began conducting joint military patrols on the contact lines between the regime forces and the opposition forces, as these patrols run along the M4 international road. These joint forces aim to monitor the implementation of the ceasefire and de-escalation on the contact lines. However, Russian forces stopped participating in these patrols in mid-September 2020.

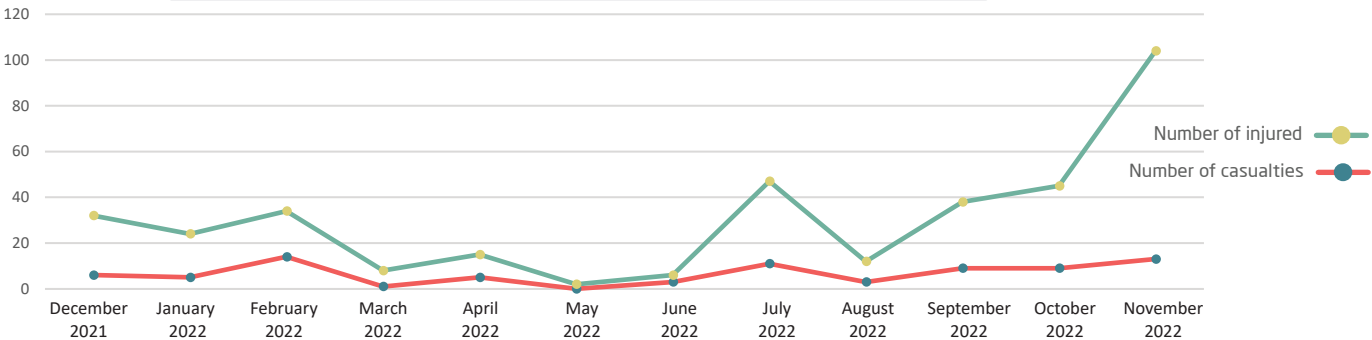

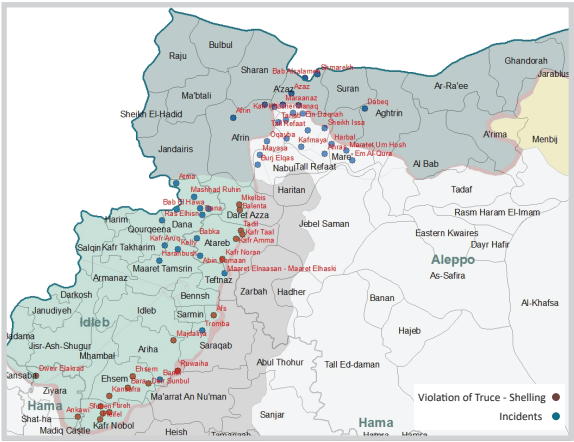


Result of the hostilities of the regime and its allies in northwest Syria

Result of the hostilities of the Regime and its allies in northwest Syria

In the camps of northwestern Syria, 29 incidents led to the burning of 28 tents, the flooding of 51 tents, the killing of 1 displaced person, and the injury of 2 displaced persons.

In northwest Syria, two IEDs exploded, killing two civilians, and injuring one civilian.

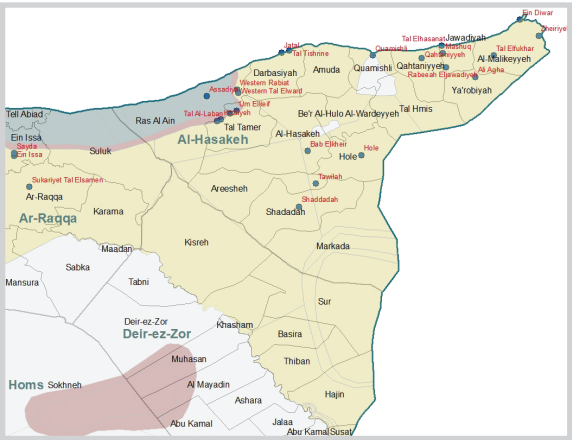
In the northern countryside of Aleppo, on 22 November 2022, the so-called Syrian Democratic Forces (SDF) fired three missiles at the city of Azaz, killing five civilians and wounding eight. In the central area of Idleb governorate, on 23 November 2022, regime forces shelled the town of Afs with heavy artillery, killing one civilian and wounding two.

In the northern countryside of Aleppo, on 25 November 2022, a child died in Azaz due to severe beatings inflicted on him by his stepfather. The child victim was seven years old. He was taken to the National Hospital in Azaz but died before reaching the hospital. According to the preliminary medical examination, the victim showed signs of severe torture, which indicates that he died under torture. The local authorities summoned the child's stepfather and mother for investigation.

In the northern countryside of Idleb and Aleppo, on 26 November 2022, heavy rains fell, causing the flooding of 12 camps. The flood led to the collapse of 11 tents and the damage of 40 tents (partial destruction) without human casualties.

In the eastern countryside of Idleb, on 29 November 2022, a United Nations aid convoy entered from the regime-controlled areas to the opposition-controlled areas from the Tromba crossing as part of a crossline aid mechanism. The convoy included 16 truckloads of food aid destined for Bab al-Hawa warehouses. This is the fourth convoy since the renewal of the UN resolution six months ago and the ninth since the decision to enter aid across the lines of contact, as this decision was taken about a year ago.

Northeast Syria





In the eastern countryside of Deir ez-Zor, on 23 November 2022, SDF carried out a campaign of arrests in the towns of Shiheil, Zir, and Al-Taqihi, where SDF deployed dozens of military vehicles and hundreds of soldiers. Heavy indiscriminate shooting occurred in Zir, resulting in a civilian's death by SDF bullets while searching his house. Explosions were heard in the vicinity of Al-Omar oil field near the city of Thiban.



In the northern countryside of Raqqqa, on 30 November 2022, dozens of tents and mud rooms collapsed in Tuwahenya and Mahmudiyyeh camps in Mansura sub-district because of heavy rains. This resulted in the death of a child due to the collapse of the roof of a mud room above him. In Al-Hasakeh governorate, on 25 November 2022, a man was killed by a woman in the Hole camp under mysterious circumstances. The exchange of shelling between the Turkish forces and the National Army on the one hand and the Syrian Democratic Forces SDF on the other hand continued.
