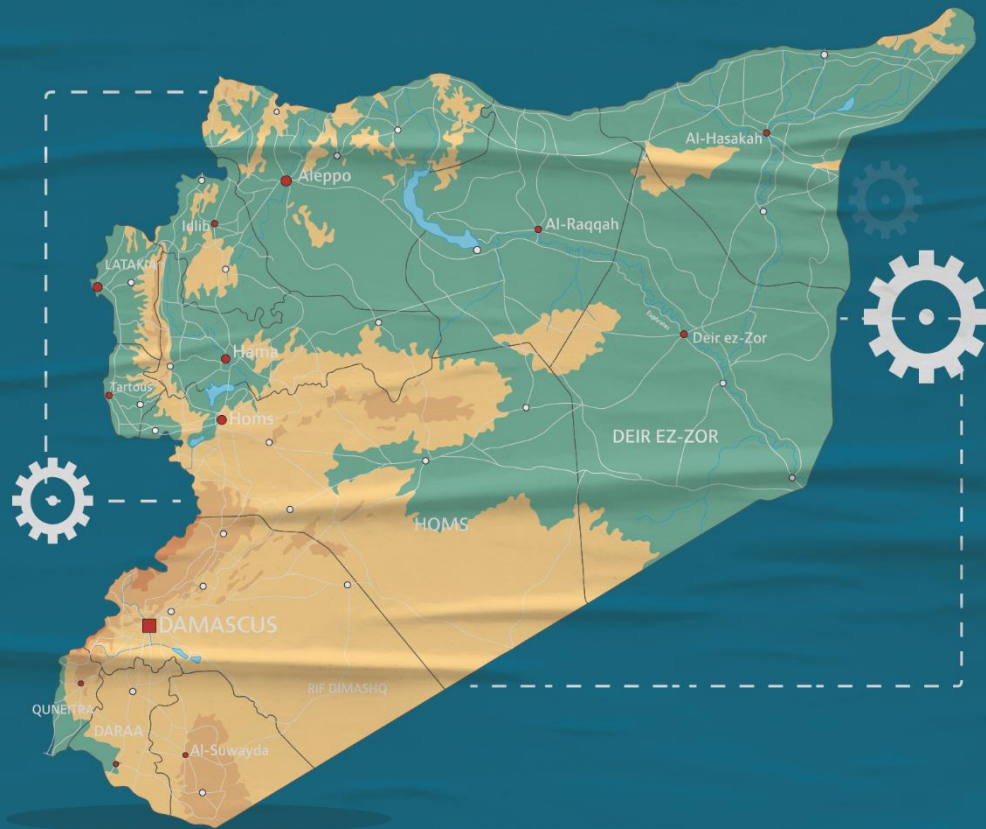


Field Updates in Syria

1-7 January 2023

Summary of Events

1-7 January 2023

Enumerators from the Information Management Unit (IMU) in the Assistance Coordination Unit (ACU) documented 31 violations by the Syrian regime and its Russian ally of the agreed ceasefire between the Turkish and Russian sides in Idlib governate and its surrounding countryside, including Aleppo, Hama, and Latakia governorates, during the period between 1 - 7 January 2023.

There were no joint Turkish-Russian military patrols between 1 - 7 January 2023. In the central area of Idlib governate, on 1 January 2023, a two-year-old girl tragically lost her life, and a man suffered from suffocation due to a fire that broke out in their house in the city of Dana. The ignition of a heater caused the fire. On 5 January 2023, the regime forces shelled the outskirts of Maaret Tamsrin city and the towns of Foah and Kafraya, using missiles launched from ground launchers. The shelling injured a woman and her four children in Al-Farousiyah Camp on the outskirts of Foah town. In the northern Idlib countryside, on 6 January 2023, a fire broke out in a house in the town of Sarmada due to the improper use of a heater. The fire injured a child and left his mother with burns. The mother's condition is critical.

On 6 January 2023 in northwestern Syria, civilians in all cities and towns under opposition control participated in demonstrations rejecting reconciliation with the regime. The protesters affirmed their commitment to the principles of the revolution. They emphasized that any solution should begin with holding the Syrian criminal regime accountable, releasing detainees, and facilitating the return of IDPs to their cities and towns.

In the northern Ar-Raqqa countryside, on 6 January 2023, a 4-year-old child passed away, and his mother and sister sustained minor burns due to a fire caused by a heater in Al-Ghabeen neighborhood in the city of Suluk.

In the eastern Deir ez-Zor countryside, on 3 January 2023, the Syrian Democratic Forces (SDF) carried out a raid operation in cooperation with coalition aircraft in the Al-Atal area, affiliated with the town of Shiheil. As a result of the operation, one person was arrested.

The Sequence of Events by Date

1 January 2023

Northwest

Enumerators from the Information Management Unit (IMU) in the Assistance Coordination Unit (ACU) documented ceasefire violations by the regime in Idleb governate and its surrounding countryside of Aleppo. In the central area of Idleb governate, regime forces heavily shelled the towns of San and Kansafra. In the southern countryside of Idleb, regime forces shelled the town of Kafr Oweid with heavy artillery.

Livelihood

In the central area of Idleb governate, a two-year-old girl tragically lost her life, and a man suffered from suffocation due to a fire that broke out in their house in the city of Dana. The ignition of a heater caused the fire.

Displacement

In the northern Idleb countryside, a fire broke out in Ghita Al-Rahma 2 Camp near the town of Sarmada due to the improper use of a cooking stove. The fire resulted in the burning of a tent and shelter materials without any human casualties.

In the northern Aleppo countryside, a fire broke out in Military Hospital Camp near the city of Afrin due to the improper use of a heater. The fire resulted in the burning of a tent and shelter materials without any human casualties.

2 January 2023

Northwest

Enumerators from the Information Management Unit (IMU) in the Assistance Coordination Unit (ACU) documented ceasefire violations by the regime in Idleb governate and its surrounding countryside of Aleppo and Latakia. In the southern countryside of Idleb governate, regime forces heavily shelled the town of Ftireh. In the western countryside of Aleppo, regime forces shelled the city of Atareb with heavy artillery. In the northern countryside of Latakia, regime forces shelled the hill town of Kabani with heavy artillery.

3 January 2023

Northwest

Enumerators from the Information Management Unit (IMU) in the Assistance Coordination Unit (ACU) documented ceasefire violations by the regime in Idleb governate and its surrounding countryside of Aleppo. In the central area of Idleb governate, regime forces heavily shelled the town of Kansafra, Bara, and Ruwayiha. In the southern countryside of Idleb, regime forces shelled the town of Sfuhen and Fleifel with heavy artillery. In the western Aleppo countryside, the Hezbollah militia affiliated with the regime targeted a civilian car at the entrance of Atareb city with a guided missile, destroying the vehicle. Regime forces shelled the town of Big Orm with heavy artillery.

Northeast

In the eastern Deir ez-Zor countryside, the Syrian Democratic Forces (SDF) carried out a raid operation in cooperation with coalition aircraft in the Al-Atal area, affiliated with the town of Shiheil. As a result of the operation, one person was arrested.

4 January 2023

Northwest

Enumerators from the Information Management Unit (IMU) in the Assistance Coordination Unit (ACU) documented ceasefire violations by the regime forces in Idleb governorate and its surrounding countryside areas in Latakia governorate. In the central area of Idleb governorate, the regime forces shelled the towns of Bara and Majdaliya with heavy artillery, attacked the town of Kafraya from ground launchers, and targeted the outskirts of Al-Farousiya Camp near the town of Foah. In the northern countryside of Latakia, regime forces shelled the hill town of Kabani with heavy artillery.

5 January 2023

Northwest

Enumerators from the Information Management Unit (IMU) in the Assistance Coordination Unit (ACU) documented ceasefire violations by the regime forces in the central area of Idleb governorate. The regime forces targeted the outskirts of Maaret Tamsrin city and the towns of Foah and Kefraya with rockets from ground launchers. The shelling injured a woman and her four children in the Al-Farousiya Camp on the outskirts of Foua town. Regime forces shelled the towns of Majdaliya, Bara, and San with heavy artillery.

Displacement

In the northern countryside of Idleb, a fire broke out in Tukan Camp near the town of Kelly due to the misuse of a heater. The fire resulted in the burning of two tents and the materials inside them and the injury of two IDPs with burns.

In the northern countryside of Aleppo, a fire broke out in Sejou Garage Camp near the town of Salama due to an electrical short circuit. The fire resulted in the burning of three tents and the materials inside them without any human casualties.

6 January 2023

Northwest

Enumerators from the Information Management Unit (IMU) in the Assistance Coordination Unit (ACU) documented ceasefire violations by the regime in Idleb governate and its surrounding countryside of Aleppo. In the central area of Idleb governate, regime forces heavily shelled the town of Ruwayiha. In the western countryside of Aleppo, regime forces shelled the towns of Qasr and Kafr Amma with heavy artillery.

In northwestern Syria, civilians in all cities and towns under opposition control participated in demonstrations rejecting reconciliation with the regime. The protesters affirmed their commitment to the principles of the revolution. They emphasized that any solution should begin with holding the Syrian criminal regime accountable, releasing detainees, and facilitating the return of IDPs to their cities and towns.

Northeast

In the northern Ar-Raqqa countryside, a 4-year-old child passed away, and his mother and sister sustained minor burns due to a fire caused by a heater in Al-Ghabeen neighborhood in the city of Suluk.

7 January 2023

Northwest

Enumerators from the Information Management Unit (IMU) in the Assistance Coordination Unit (ACU) documented ceasefire violations by the regime in Idleb governate and its surrounding countryside of Aleppo. In the central area of Idleb governate, regime forces heavily shelled the town of Ruwayiha. In the western countryside of Aleppo, regime forces shelled the town of Taqad with heavy artillery and rockets from ground launchers. Heavy artillery shelled the towns of Kafr Thoran and Kafr Taal.

Livelihood

In the northern Idleb countryside, a fire broke out in a house in the town of Sarmada due to the improper use of a heater. The fire injured a child and his mother with burns. The mother's condition is critical.

Displacement

In the northern Idleb countryside, a fire broke out in Kafr Tanour Camp near the town of Kafr Tanour due to the misuse of a heater. The fire resulted in the burning of a tent and the materials inside it without any human casualties. A fire broke out in Al-Taakhi Camp near the town of Delbiya due to the misuse of a cooking stove. The fire resulted in the burning of a tent and the materials inside it without any human casualties. A fire broke out in

Abu Talha Camp near the town of Abu Talha due to an electrical short circuit. The fire resulted in the burning of a tent and the materials inside it without any human casualties. A fire broke out in Zahret Al-Sham Camp near the town of Babsqa due to the improper use of a cooking stove. The fire resulted in the burning of a tent and the materials inside it without any human casualties. A fire broke out in Al-Muhandiseen 1 Camp near the town of Mreimin due to the improper use of a heater. The fire resulted in the burning of a tent and the materials inside it without any human casualties. A fire broke out in Ikhaa Hama Camp near the town of Sarmada due to the improper use of a heater. The fire resulted in the burning of a tent and the materials inside it and caused burns to three IDPs. As a result of heavy rainfall, the tents in Al-Iman Camp near the town of Atma were flooded, leading to the destruction of nine tents.
