As of the release of the field developments dashboard on August 2023 ,2, the Syrian regime and its Russian ally have committed 290 ceasefire violations. It is notable that despite Turkey and Russia reaching a ceasefire agreement in Idlib on March 2020 ,5, these areas continue to be targeted with heavy artillery and rocket fire.
