As of the release of the field developments dashboard on August 2023<sup>2</sup>, the Syrian regime and its Russian ally have committed 293 ceasefire violations. It is notable that despite Turkey and Russia reaching a ceasefire agreement in Idlib on March 2020<sup>5</sup>, these areas continue to be targeted with heavy artillery and rocket fire.
